Branch Officer Leader Course (BOLC) Purpose

To develop competent and confident leaders, regardless of branch, grounded in field craft,

skilled in leading soldiers, training subordinates,

and employing and maintaining equipment.





- Branch Officer Leader Course (BOLC)
 - Say BOLICK
 - Two phases
 - BOLC 1 is new
 - BOLC 2 replaces BOBC
 - Implemented FY03 (1 Oct 02)



- BOLC 1(continued)
 - All branches except CH, JA, and AMEDD less
 MS
 - Classes will contain a mix of gender, C, CS, CSS, and International students
 - Training conducted a 1 central location (Benning-?), may add another site if required (location TBD)
 - Course POI not finalized



- BOLC 1 (continued)
 - Initial accessioning for Active component officers
 - Common core subjects
 - 6 weeks duration
 - 24 % classroom or garrison
 - 76 % field environment



- BOLC 1 (continued)
 - Some tasks taken from precommissioning tasks
 - Some tasks taken from BOBC
 - BOBC reduced 3 weeks (+/-) and becomes
 BOLC 2
 - BOLC 1 taken TDY enroute to BOLC 2
 - Except for Aviation, BOLC remains a TDY



- BOLC 1 (continued)
 - 2 pilot classes in FY01 (49 ARNG in 1st, 25 in 2d)
 - 2 pilot classes in FY02 (13Jan-1Mar & 24Feb-12Apr)
 - Total implementation in FY03
 - May add another pilot in FY01 (Aug-Oct) or FY02 (Oct-Dec)

- BOLC 1 Critical Skills (must pass)
 - Meet height and weight standards
 - Pass APFT (minimum of 60 each event)
 - 50% GO ratings in leadership positions
 - Qualify with M16A2 or M4
 - Complete 4 and 6-mile road marches
 - Run 3 miles under 27 minutes



- BOLC 1 Desired Skills (should pass/complete)
 - Pass CWST
 - Run 4 miles under 36 minutes
 - Complete 8-mile foot marches
 - Pass basic day/night land nav
 - Leadership exam



- BOLC 1 problem areas
 - Forecasting training requirements
 - Scheduling (enroute to BOLC 2)
 - Transportation HS to BOLC 1 to BOLC 2 to HS
 - Increase in time and expense





- Captain's Career Course (CCC)
 - Includes BOAC (technical) & CAS3 (staff action)
 - Most schools developing DL phase(s)
 - CAS3 DL phase to replace TATS 2A phase
 - TATS-C courses being developed
 - Moving toward training at Integrating





- Command and General Staff Course (CGSC)
 - All officers attend a 12-16 week resident phase
 - OPCF (Opns Career Fld) attend resident Advanced Warfighting
 - Other officers will attend resident FA (functional area) courses in their specific FA
 - USAR and correspondence options to



- SSC training
 - NGB-ART memo dated 7Mar01
 - Suspense 21Aug01
 - Selection Board to convene 24Sep01
- CGSOC training

- US Army Aviation School (USAAVNS) issues

- FY02 Aviation controlled-quota distribution

- Program for ROTC non-graduates
