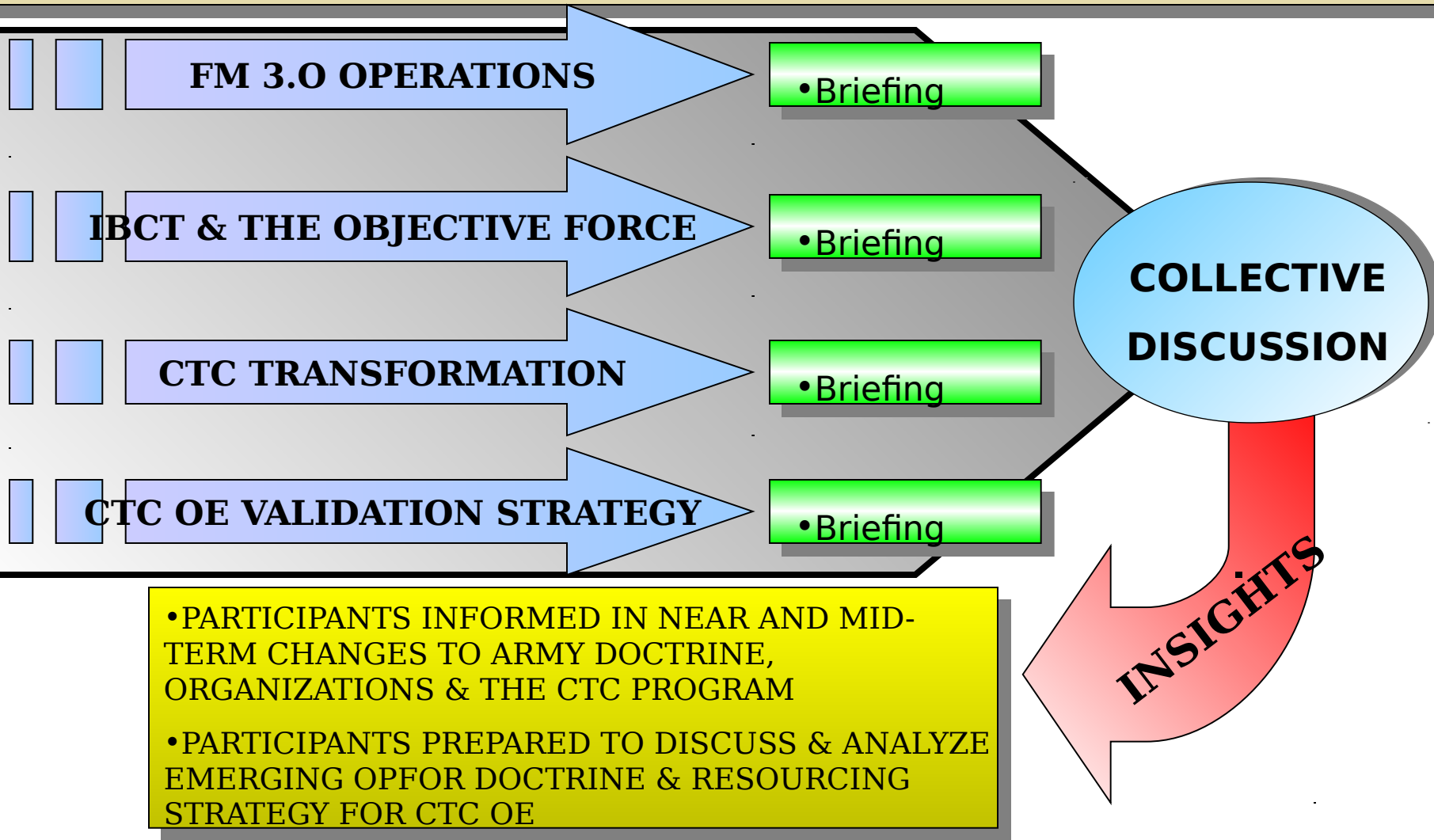

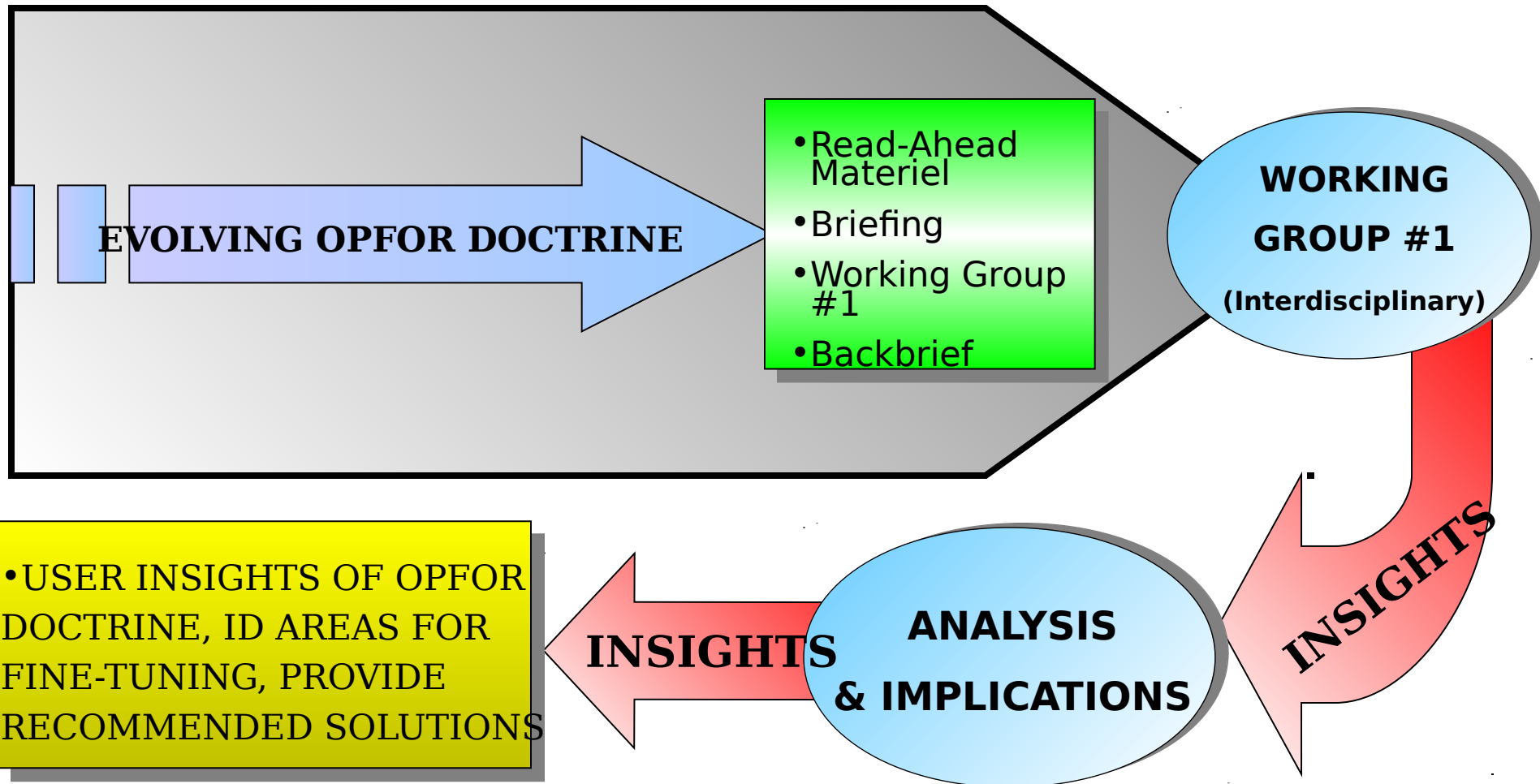
DAY 1: END STATE OBJECTIVES

- 2. Foundation laid for Day 2 - Participants prepared to receive briefings and conduct analysis of selected OPFOR doctrine.**



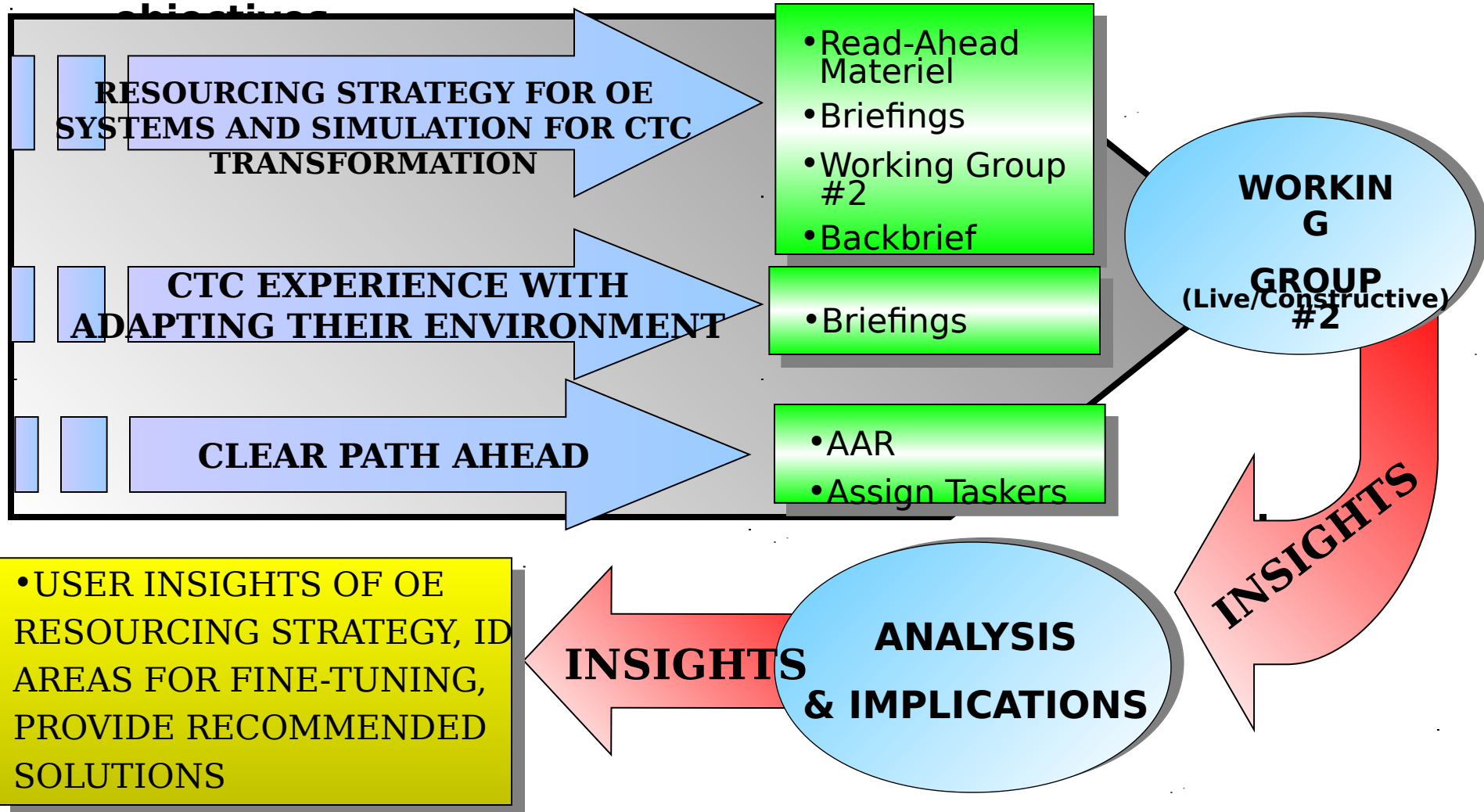
DAY 2: END STATE OBJECTIVES
