

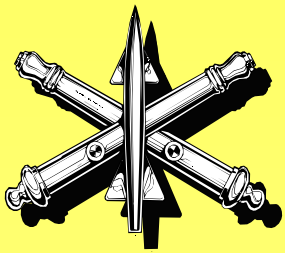

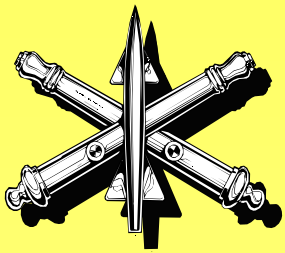

PROPONENT INITIATIVES AFFECTING TASS

- ➔ **Assignment Oriented Training has had a positive impact on both the AC and RC.**
- **14J School rearranged the course so that a soldier assigned SHORAD unit will receive the 14J MOS after 10 weeks of training.**
- **A soldier assigned to a Patriot unit will remain for an additional 9 weeks of training and receive an ASI.**
- **The 10 week length of time to receive the 14J MOS is easily met by the RC to fit into one TATS training year.**

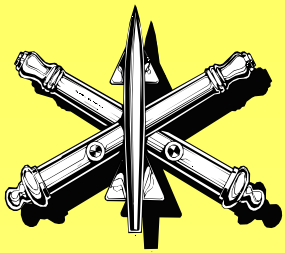
PROPONENT ISSUES AFFECTING TASS

- **The length of time to certify RC Instructors**

- **For Example: The current 14J 19 week course takes approximately 1 year. Due to the complexity of the MOS 6th BDE Recommendation, it takes 3 iterations to become instructor certified**

- **TRADOC Reg 350-70 recommends at least 2 iterations**

- **Funding and finding RC instructors for this length of time**



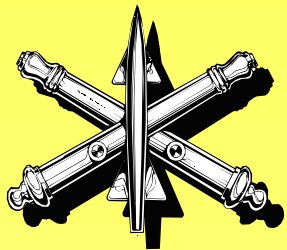
