

SARSS WORKLOAD MAINT FILE

PROBLEM: Today the SARSS's automatically cuts job orders to maintenance causing all unserviceables to be shipped in to the maintenance activity.

SARSS ECP: An ECP has been written for SARSS to develop a Workload Maintenance File (MWF). The MWF will be uploaded with the National Workload Plan (NIIN & QTY). This change will control unserviceable flow in to the maintenance activity.


Policy Extract

- Package IAW NICP Packaging and Preservation Instructions in FEDLOG.
- Local, Regional, and repair and return shipments that are for immediate use will be packaged to prevent deterioration of the item to a lower condition code. Local design shall be performed if determined less costly than military requirements or if no military requirement exists, except for reusable containers.
- OCONUS Shipments, where original packaging has been compromised, military preservation and level A pack applies IAW FEDLOG.
- If an item's original vendor or depot packaging must be upgraded at time of receipt or shipment, the receiver or shipper can request reimbursement from the NICP on DD Form 1225 IAW AR 740-3, Care of S




