

GOAL

A program that maximizes equipment, classroom, and instructor resources that leverages unit capability, reduces student TDY costs, and qualifies the soldier on critical skills, while maintaining the standards of The Army Training System - Courses specified by TRADOC and Proponent Schools without disruption of unit collective training cycles.



On Track

1st QTR Quarterly Army Performance Review (QAPR) Results

- PAARNG executed the second highest number of total quotas, nationally(behind CAARNG), with a 101% Usage rate (148 inputs for 146 quotas). Compared to the national average 77% (48 inputs for 62 quotas per state average) -- (discounting CA and PA)
- PAARNG executed the third highest number of MOSQ Reclassification quotas, nationally (behind CAARNG and TNARNG), with a 98% usage rate (50 inputs for 51 quotas). Compared to the national average 69% (12 inputs for 17 quotas per state average) -- (discounting CA, TN, and PA)

PAARNG is currently 78% DMOSQ State-wide

Cross Component Resourcing

- 1. MOA is Agreement between DIV (IT) and State
 - Authorized by NGB and USARC
 - Signed copy sent to NGB-ART-I
 - Must have budget breakdown (APPENDIX B)
- 2. USARC transfers funds to NGB (or opposite)
 - NGB-ARC establishes OPEN ALLOTMENT ACCOUNT
 - NGB-ARC sends account classification to state USPFO

OR

- USARC accepts NGB Funds, then disperses to DIV (IT)
- 3. Orders are written at state using the Open Allotment Account
 - Copies of orders sent to NGB-ARC or USARC for accounting purposes



Cross Component Resourcing

TASS Cross Component Resourcing MOU (06 May 97) between DA DCSOPS, NGB, USARC, USASOC, FORSCOM, and TRADOC

Pay and Allowance funds, Open Allotment

- Must be transferred at NGB/USARC Level
- IAW Funding Reimbursement Authority
- Instructor funds (RPA and NGPA)
- \$600K Funding Reimbursable Authority for NGB

OMNG and OMAR Funds

- May be transferred at State/DIV (IT) Level
- Classroom Facilities Costs
- Supplies
- Equipment Costs
- Utility Costs
