



AGR-Reserve LT Program



Each year, Cadet Command will nominate 25-50 cadets to go on active duty with the Army Reserve in the AGR program. Procedures to apply are listed on the right:

Application/Selection Procedure:

- Volunteer notifies PMS & checks AGR Duty Volunteer Accessions Packet Block NLT mid-Sep of commissioning year
- PMS provides full name, SSN, Branch, National OML Ranking, CDT phone & PMS phone NLT 1 Mar of commissioning year to ACOS-R, USACC.
- HRC-St. Louis's Army Reserve Active Duty Management Division's (ARADMD) ROTC Liaison Officer will call volunteers listed in order of their OML to put on orders.
- AGR LT, upon commissioning, will immediately attend AGR entry training at Ft. McCoy for two weeks, then report back to ROTC detachment to serve as a Reserve Goldbar Recruiter until it's time to attend OBC.
