**MRC Operating Patterns:** Integrated combined/joint operations, use of complex terrain and urban environments for sanctuary, extensive CCD, movement timed to ISR patterns, night operations, use of civilian population, manipulating the coalition, extensive IO, adequate power projection, asymmetric means.

## How it will Fight

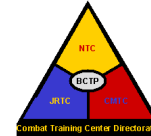
Threat forces will:
