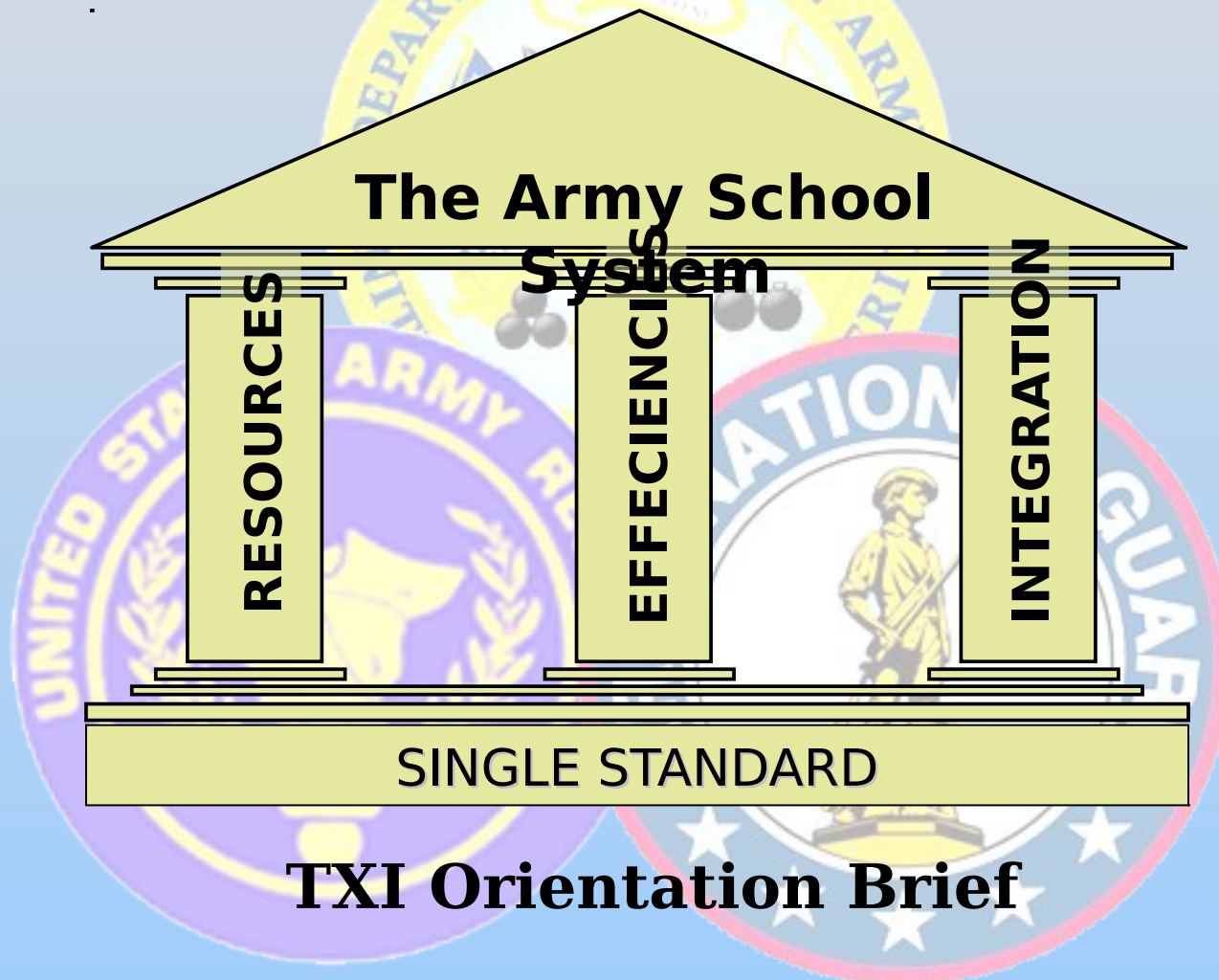

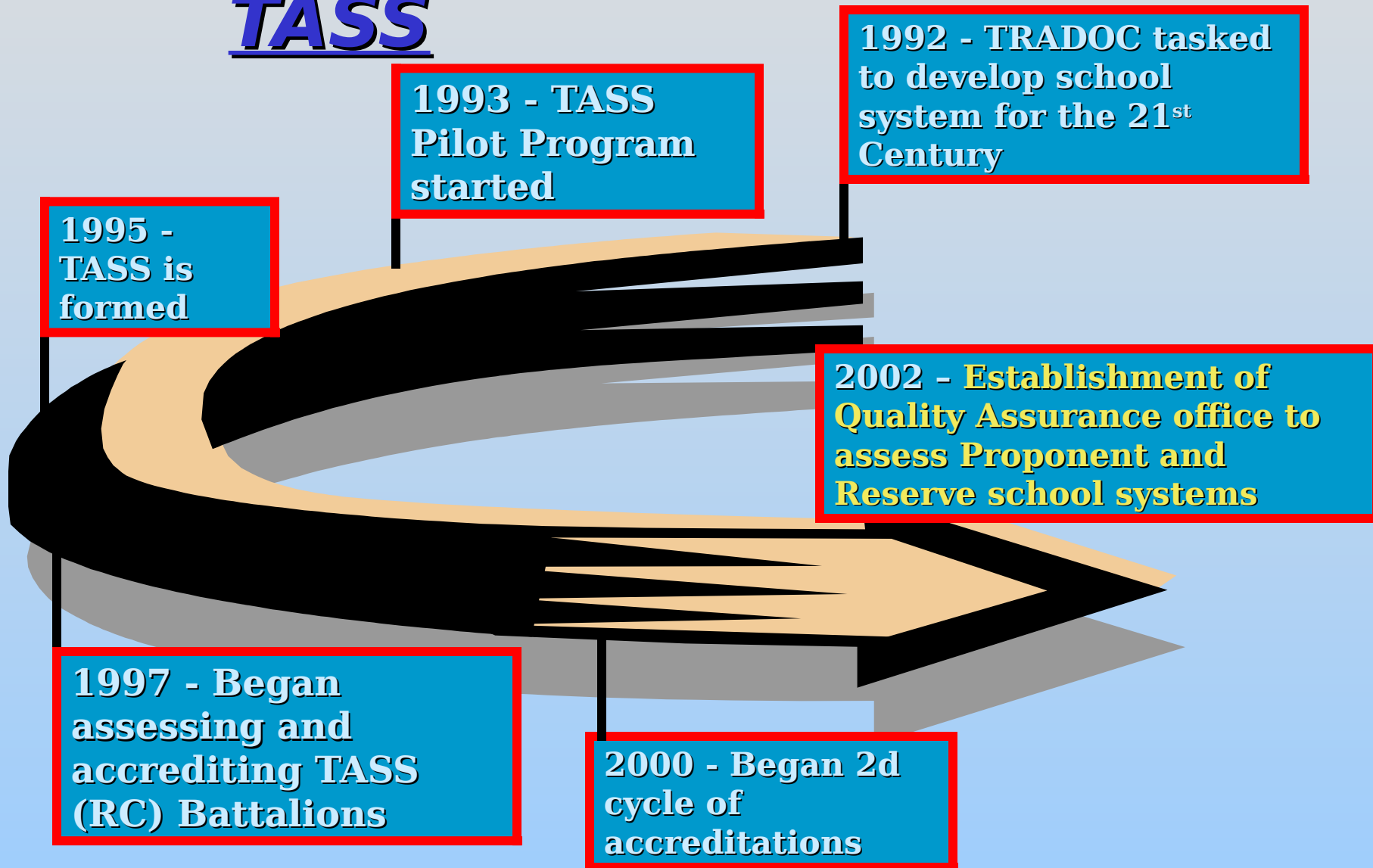

The Evolution of *TASS*



What is TASS?

- **The Institutional Army's total force integration vehicle**
- **Comprised of all Active and Reserve Component training institutions; Centers, Proponent schools, Training Battalions (AC/RC),**
- **Encompasses doctrine, training, leader and combat developments**



Why TASS?

- **TASS trains to ONE standard**
- **TASS brings the training resources of The ARMY together (AC/USAR/ARNG)**
- **TASS improves training availability... more instructors, more training locations**
- **TASS guarantees that soldiers from all components attending TATS courses will receive equivalent credit**



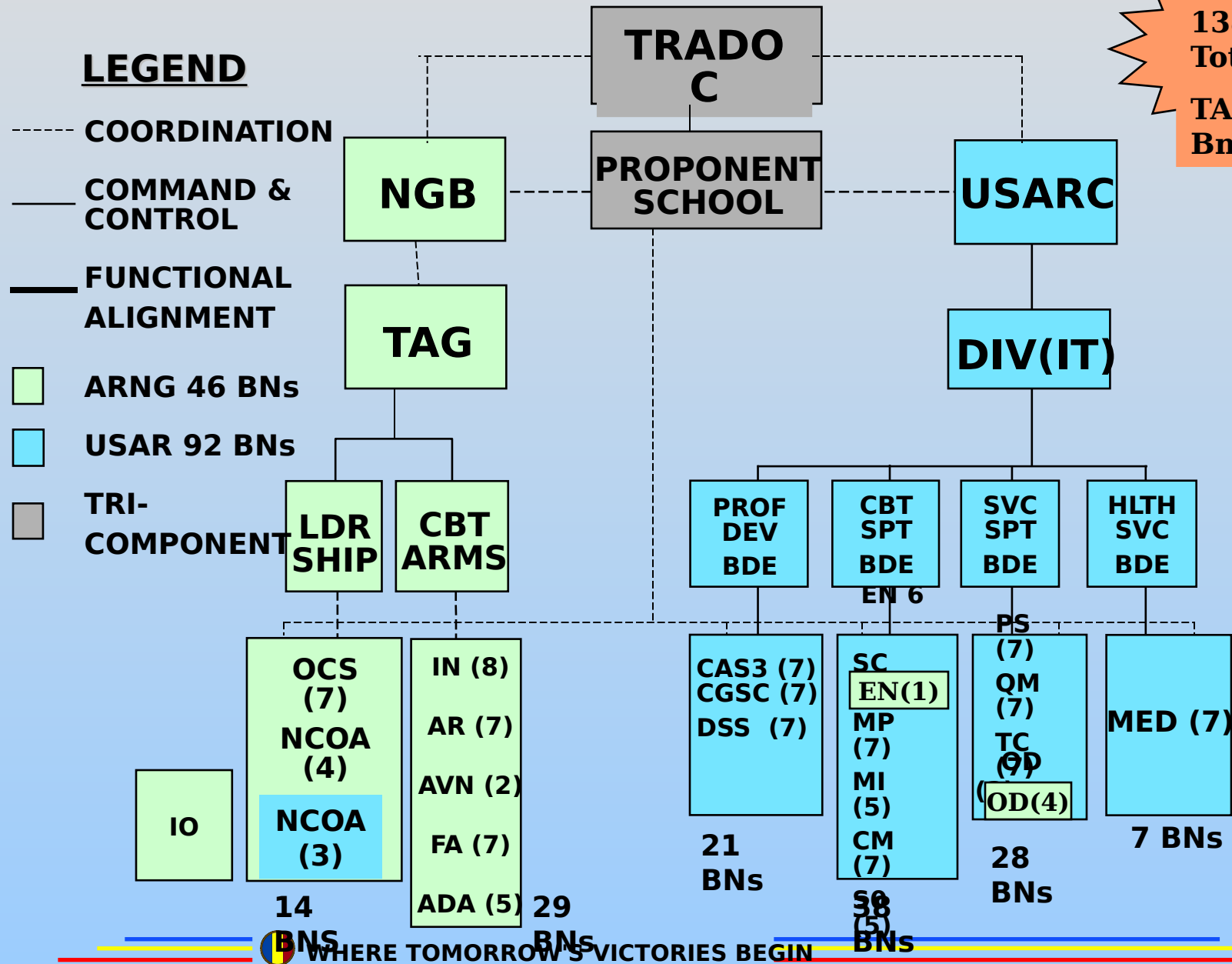
Components of **TASS**

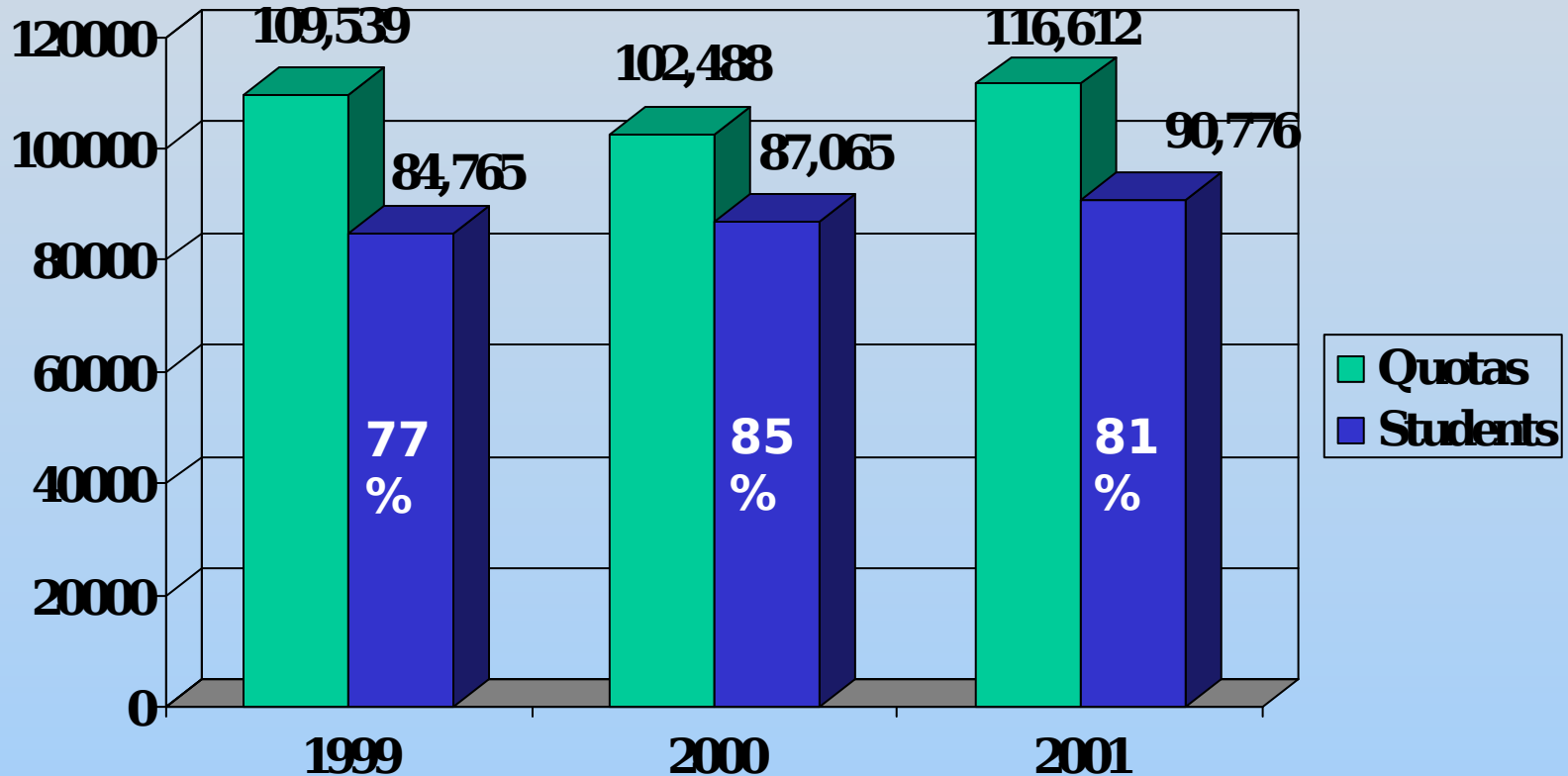

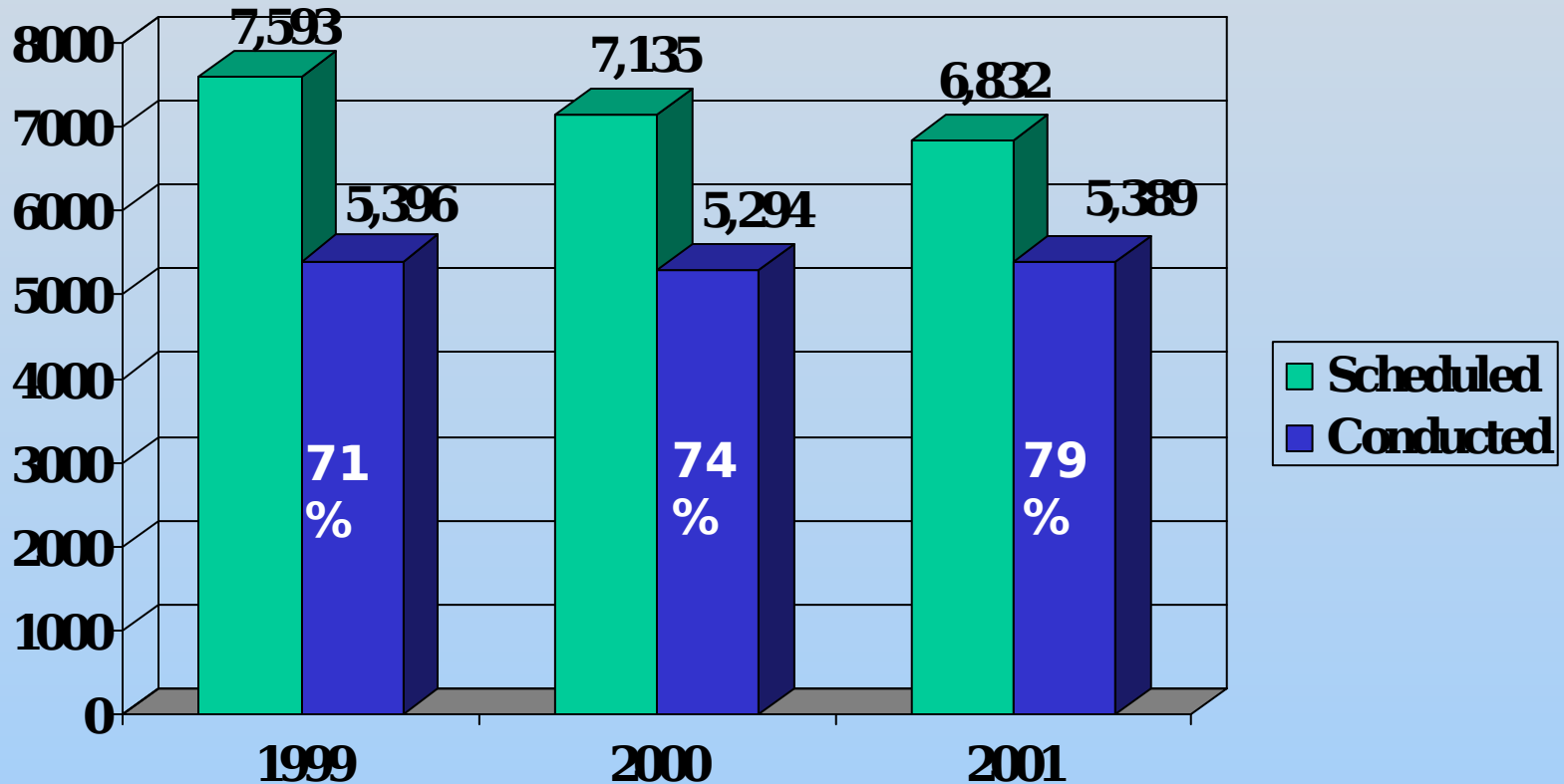
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Quota Utilization

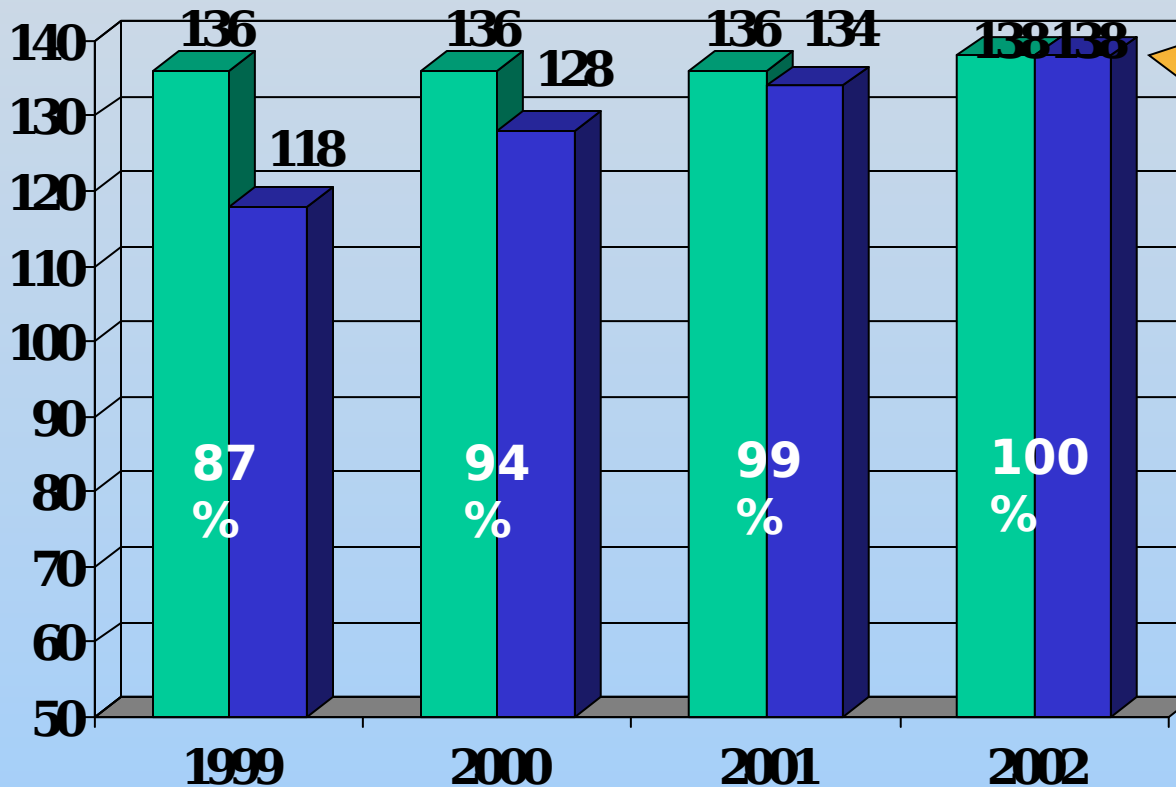

Battalion Accreditation



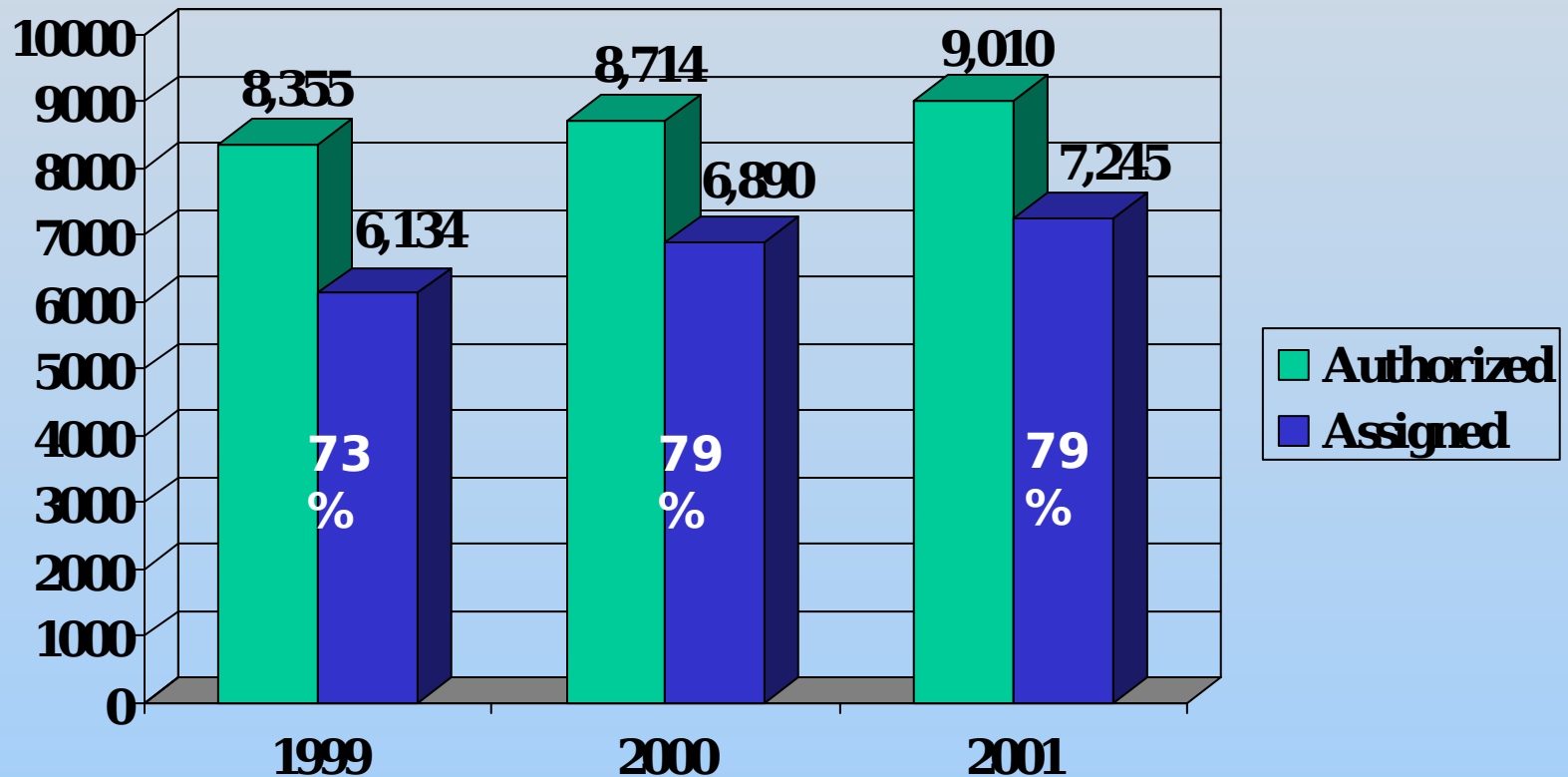

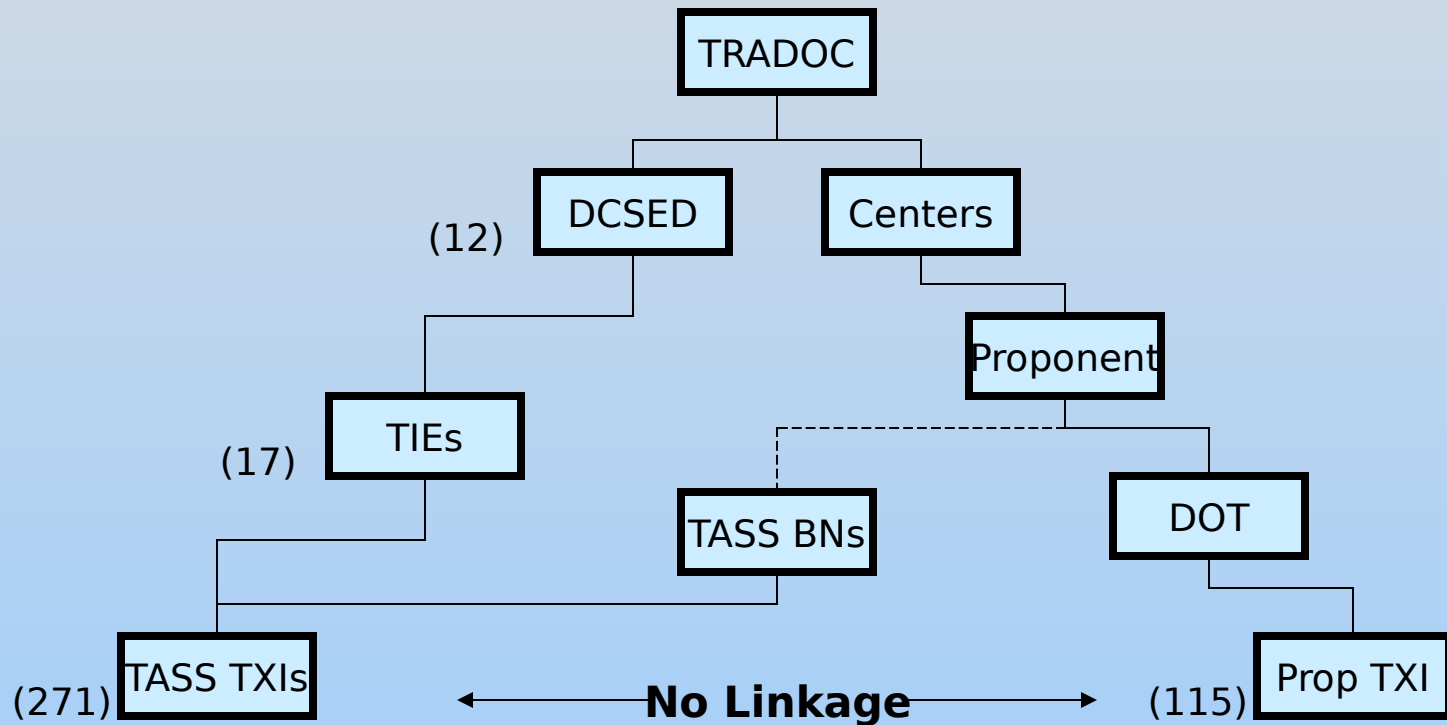


Purpose of Title XI Program

- Title XI is a congressionally mandated program to provide AC support to the RC for training and education.
- Intent is to increase readiness of the RC and to enhance overall effectiveness of the Army.
- TRADOC Title XIs have been principally engaged in: TASS battalion accreditation, instructor certification, and courseware development and implementation.

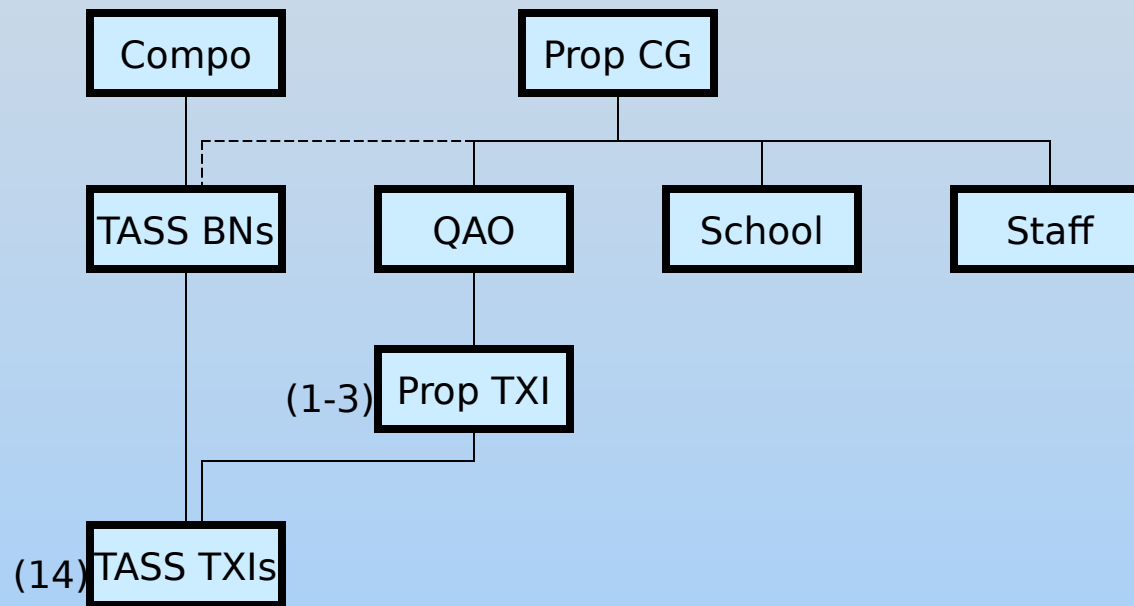

New Concept

- Create a single Quality Assurance Program
 - RC Accreditation Program
 - AC Quality Assurance Program
- Align Title XI assets with QA Program
- Close TASS Integration Elements (TIEs)
- Provide Title XI linkage at the Center QAOs
- Link TASS Bn Title XIs to Proponent Title XIs
- Assign TASS Bn Title XIs to Ft Monroe with “duty at” TASS Bn location

Benefits of Change

- Improve accreditation standardization
- Improve coordination between proponents and their TASS battalions
- Improve orientation and training of Title XI personnel
- Fulfill obligation to return RC AGR investment



Measurement of Success

- Proponent-certified instructors capable of teaching up-to-date courseware and ensuring students perform to standard.
- Fully accredited TASS battalions that meet assigned ARPRINT mission.
- Courseware that ensures a single Army standard on critical tasks.



Duties and Responsibilities

Title XIs at Center QAOs

- Assist Center QAO in program management with emphasis on RC
- Trends, analysis and resolution of HHIs
- Sponsor, orient and train proponent Title XIs
- Provide support to proponent Title XIs



Duties and Responsibilities

Title XIs at Proponent Schools

- Work with TASS Bn commands
- Provide supervision/support to TASS Bn Title XIs
- Assist QAE with annual Master Eval Plan
- Conduct QA evaluations of TASS Bns
- Formulate COAs to correct deficiencies
- Coordinate TD issues with TASS Bns
- Sponsor, orient and train TASS Bn Title XIs



Duties and Responsibilities

Title XIs at TASS Battalions

- Assist TASS Bn with assigned training mission
- Liaison between TASS Bn and proponent
- Conduct instructor certification program
- Provide professional development to instructors
- Critique class instruction/instructors
- Assist coordination of training products
- Assist proponent with QA of other TASS Bns



Administrative **Impact**

- TASS Bn Title XI personnel records serviced by Ft Eustis PSB
- TASSD Pers Div will do all requisitions
- Increased involvement of proponent Title XI in personnel actions for TASS Bn Title XIs
- Increase in Title XI budget to proponent
- Increase in travel orders processing

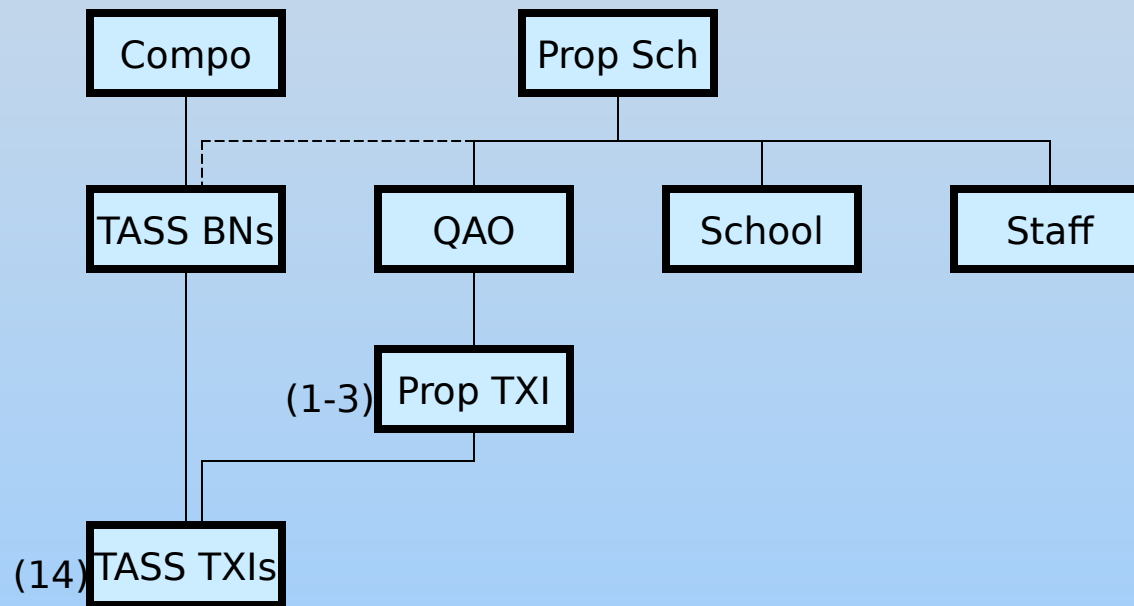

- ♦ 27,487 Dept of Defense/State Civilians

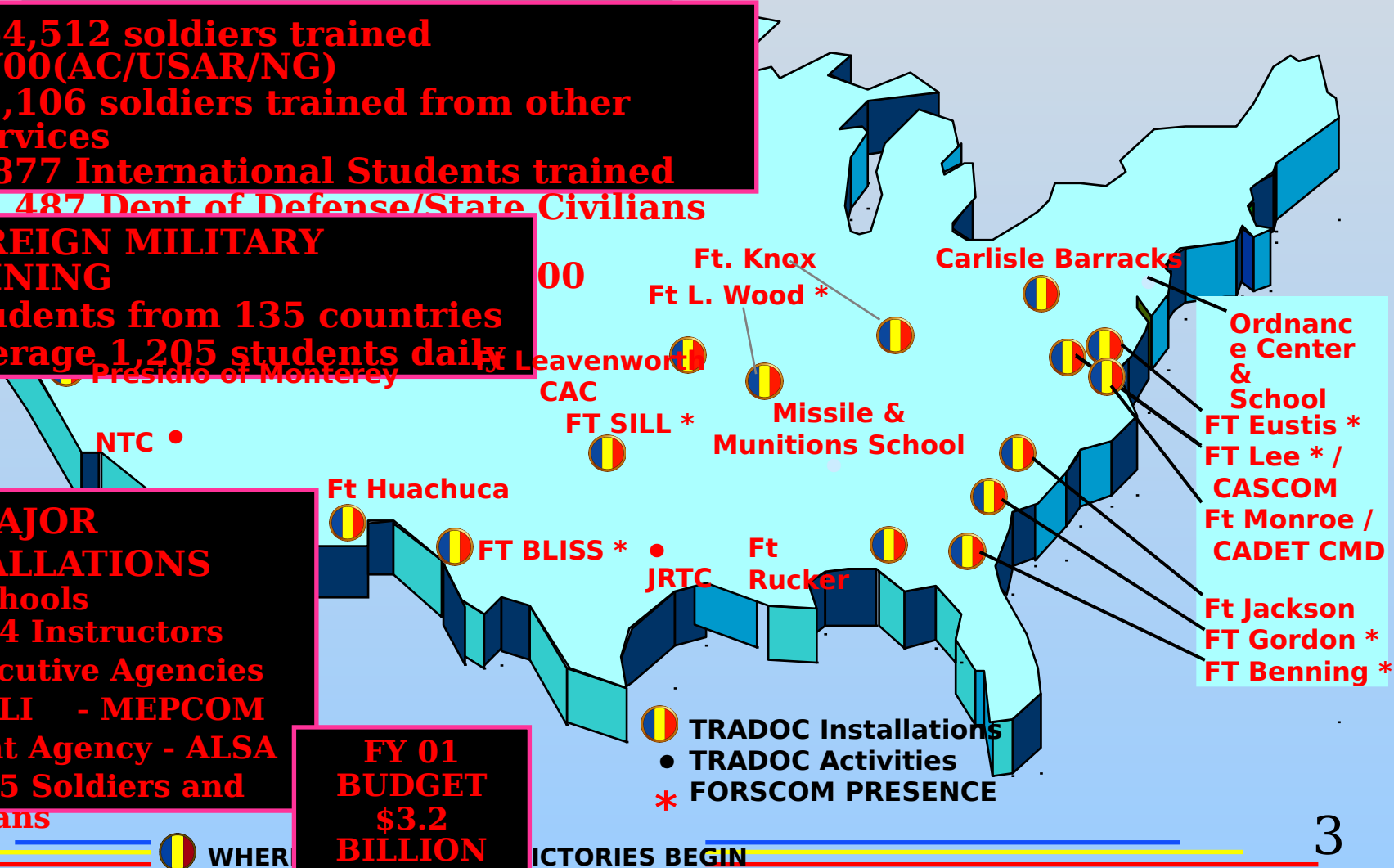
FOREIGN MILITARY TRAINING

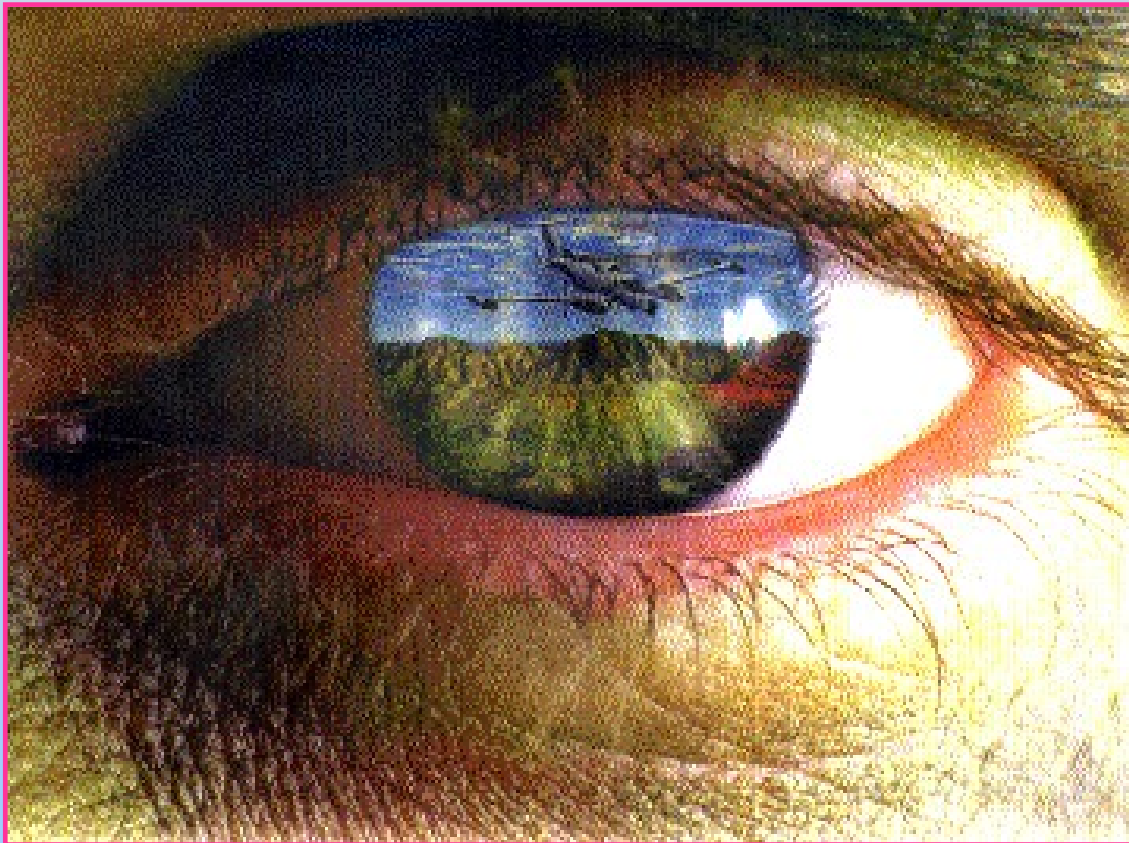

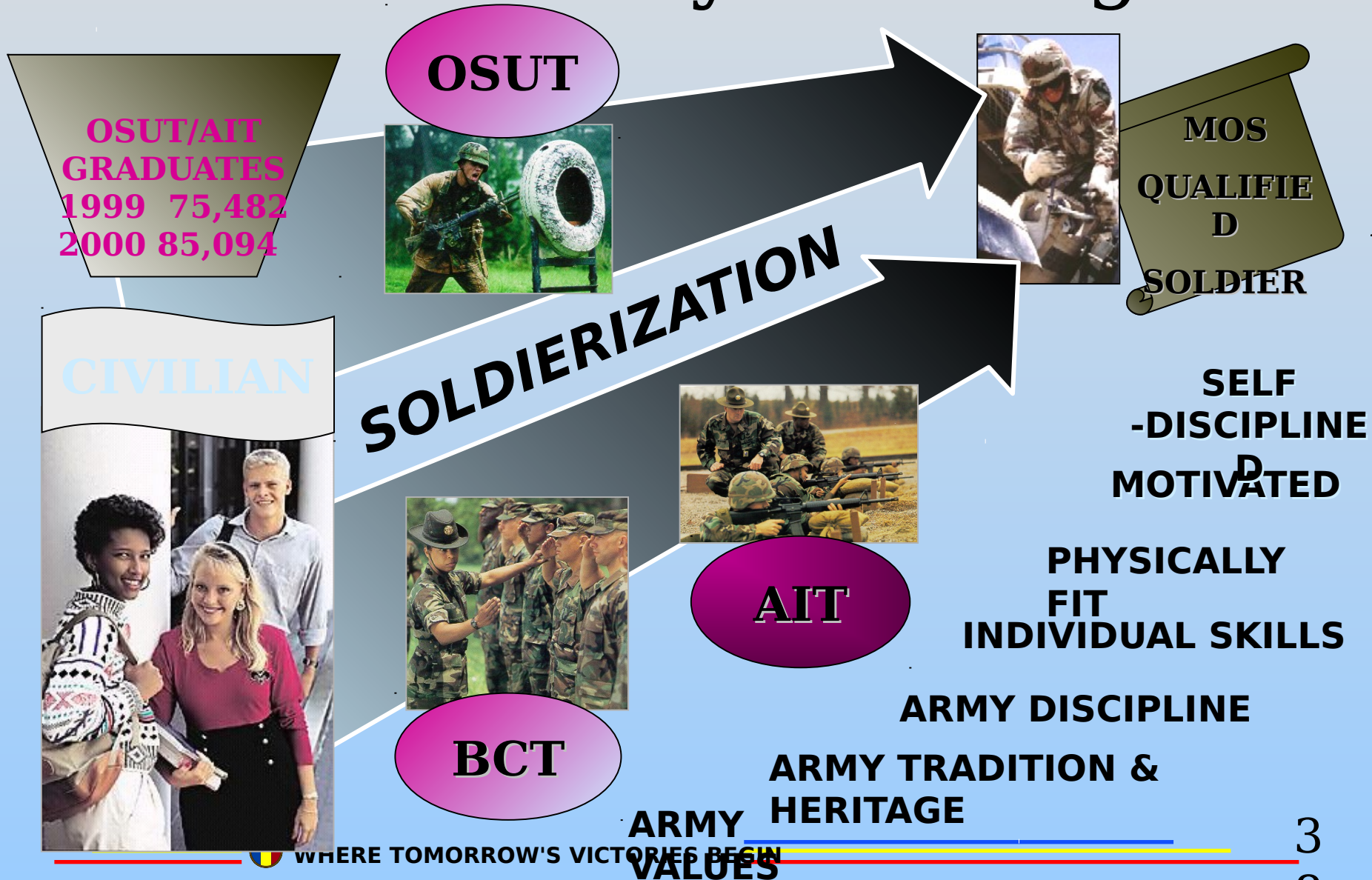

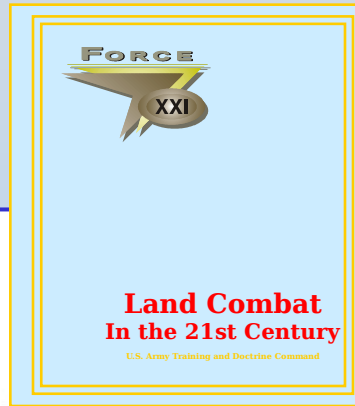
