
INTERIM BRIGADE -- RED TEAM (IBRT)

IBRT METHODOLOGY PROCESS



WARGAME #1 - Interim Brigade Operating in

Stability and Support Operation along Serbian, Bulgarian, Romanian Borde United Nations Involvement, Forced Entry by Army Europe, Based on Kosov Founded on TF Hawk Plan and Task Organization, Split-Station Plans, etc.

Plan, Prep, Task Organize, Alert, Marshall, Stage

Initial forces deploy by Strat Air into theater, Tactical Air into AO; Follow-On Forces deploy by sea to port, rail and roadmarch into AO until air LOC is secure (D+60)

DEPLOY

Operations (SASO) under 1st ID (M) ARFOR HQ, as part of a EUCOM JTF. Area of Operations (AO) characterized by mountainous terrain, numerous urban areas (small town to large village), numerous foreign military organizations and police forces. Operate in proximity with JSOTF and JPOTF forces, Peace Making Focus, and Protection of NGOs

EMPLOY

JTF Lead unit in country, initial force of Coalition, O/O accept support from 30 countries representing United Nations Forces and NATO. O/O Assist JSOC and US Department of State (DOS) in Non-combatant evacuation Operations (NEO), repatriation/asylum ops

REDEPLOY

Conduct relief in place with Heavy Brigade from V Corps. Redeploy by rail and road to port. Equipment and supplies containerized to redeploy via, commercial vessel. Personnel by MILAIR
