




So You Want To Be Drug Free!

THE FIRST QUESTION

- **IS TIMED**

1. Choose two students or two teachers from the group to judge the first, second, third, fourth, etc. student's **HAND** that goes up.




THE FIRST QUESTION

RULE 1 of THE GAME

- **Every contestant receives two “Lifelines.”**
 - 1. He or she can ask a pre-selected friend for help answering one question only. Ask the contestant to choose a “lifeline friend.”**



RULE 1 of THE GAME

- **Every contestant receives two “Lifelines.”**

2. He or she can ask fellow students to vote on the right answer to one question only.


- **Both lifelines can be used on one question**



RULE 2 of THE GAME


ALL QUESTIONS are multiple choice, with only ONE correct answer.

Each correct answer may earn the contestant a prize or award.



RULE 2 of THE GAME


As the questions become more difficult to answer correctly, the awards get better, with the top award going to question number eight.



RULE 2 of THE GAME...

cont.


- **As soon as a contestant picks an incorrect answer, the game ends.**
- **If time and prizes remaining permit, a new contestant is selected, and another “round” is played.**



RULE 3 of THE GAME

- Each game has five sets of eight questions.
- The number of “rounds” you play is limited only by the amount of time remaining and the number of “rewards” or prizes available or we may play for the fun of it!
