Duplicate Stock Numbers

- Definition: A stock number that appears on multiple contracts linked to the same "Ordering Point"
- Objective: Decrease the number of item dupes to reduce following problems
 - Service systems can't download catalogs
 - Item supported by more than one contract (goes against contract support language)

Reasons Dupes Occur

- Item added to catalog by mistake
- Contract added to ordering point where item support already exists on another contract
- Ordering point supports customers outside of original "region" (To support regionalization and other efforts)

Solving Reasons 1 & 2

- Remove item(s) from offending contract
- Automated help for finding errors
 - Email notification to admin users of ordering points with dupes
 - Duplicate item checker on active catalog
 - Developing tool to check dupes in catalog updates
 - Developing tool to check dupes in proposed contract support

Ordering Point Supports Customers Outside of Original "Region"
