



Other Papers, Etc., Books, Photos, Circulars, and all 3rd class Mail Matter, 1 cent gold for each 2 ounces or fraction thereof.

Registration, 10 cents, in addition to the regular postage.

PARCEL POST:—Merchandise, including Samples, and all other Fourth Class Mail Matter, weighing four ounces or less, one cout gold for each ounce or fraction thereof; weighing more than four ounces, twelve cents gold for the first pound and twelve cents for each additional pound or fraction of a pound. Limit of weight, 20 lbs.

Forwarding of Parcels:—Shanghai is the only place in China to which the Domestic Parcel Post applies. Parcels received at this Agency cannot be remailed or forwarded to interior places without prepayment of addition-

al postage, which cannot be advanced by this Agency.

Insurance:—A mailable parcel on which the postage is fully prepaid may be Insured against loss in an amount equivalent to its actual value, but not to exceed U. S. \$50.00, on payment of a fee of ten cents in stamps; such stamps to be affixed. When a parcel is Insured the sender will be given a receipt for the same.

To Postal Union Countries:-

Letters, 5 cents for first onnce; 3 cents for each additional ounce;

postcards, 2 cents.

Newspapers and other printed matter, 1 cent for each 2 ounces or fraction. Bonatide Trade Samples not exceeding 12 ounces in weight, 2 cents for the first 4 ounces and 1 cent for each additional 2 ounces or fraction.

Rates to Non-Union Countries are the same as Union Countries.

Mails from the United States are forwarded by the Agency to any post office of the Imperial Chinese Post. Residents of interior ports should have

their correspondence addressed to one of these ports.

Money Orders:—Money orders are issued for payment in the United States and its island possessions (Guam, Hawaii, Porto Rico, and Tutuila, Samoa) and in Bermuda, British Guiana, British Honduras, Canada, the Canal Zone, Cuba, Mexico, Newfoundland, the Philippine Islands, and certain islands of the West Indies.

For Orders for sums not exceeding \$2.50, 3 cents; \$2.50 to \$5.00, 5 cents; \$5.00 to \$10.00, 8 cents; \$10.00 to \$20.00, 10 cents; \$20.00 to \$30.00, 12 cents; \$30.00 to \$40.00, 15 cents; \$40.00 to \$50.00, 18 cents; \$50.00 to \$60.00, 20 cents; \$60.00 to \$75.00, 25 cents; \$75.00 to \$100.09, 30 cents.


