Insurance:—A mailable parcel on which the postage is fully prepaid may be Insured against loss in an amount equivalent to its actual value, but not to exceed U. S. \$100, on payment of a fee of 3 cents in stamps for \$5,00; 5 cents for ± 25 ; 10 cents for 50; 25 cents for 100, stamps to be affixed. C.O.D. Parcels may be sent from Shanghai to U.S.A. or Mauila up to value of \$100,00.

TO POSTAL UNION AND NON-UNION COUNTRIES :---

Letters, 5 cents for 1 oz.; 3 cents for each added; postcards, 2 cents.

Newspapers and other printed matter, 1 cent for each 2 ounces or fraction. Bonafide Trade Samples not exceeding 12 ounces in weight, 2 cents for the first 4 ounces and 1 cent for each additional 2 ounces or fraction.

MONEY ORDERS: —Are issued for payment in United States and its island pessessions (Guam, Hawaii, Porto Rico, Virgin Islands, and Tutnila, Samoa) and in Bermuda, British Guiana, British Honduras, Canada, the Canal Zone, Cuba, the Philippine Islands, and certain of the West Indies.

In applying for a Postal Money Order, give the name and address of the party to whom made payable and the name and address of the party sending.

Money orders are issued in exchange for Shanghai Dollars at the current rate of exchange, or for Gold dollars.

For Orders for sums not exceeding \$2.50, 3 cents; \$2.50 to \$5.00, 5 cents; \$5.00 to \$10.00, 8 cents; \$10.00 to \$20.00, 10 cents; \$20.00 to \$30.00, 12 cents; \$30 00 to \$40.00, 15 cents; \$40.00 to \$50.00, 18 cents; \$50.00 to \$60.00, 20 cents; \$60.00 to \$75.00, 25 cents; \$75.00 to \$100.00, 30 cents.

Note: Mail for other places in China is sent direct from the United States to the Chinese Exchange Office and is not handled at the Agency. Requests to redirect mail from one place to another in China or to hold mail at Shangha, which is addressed to outports cannot be complied with.


