

THE OLD CATHEDRAL Basilica of St. Louis, King of France

Completed in 1834, the Old Cathedral is only building remaining in Jefferson National Expansion Memorial, on the downtown St. Louis riverfront. A 1963 rehabilitation program returned church to close approximation of original appearance. Organ came from France early in 19th century. Canopeoum and tintinnabulum, symbols of Basilica, are seen in background.
