Our new blogs platform uses Disqus, a new blog comment service, that were not compatible with importing the old comments. The old comments are still available here on My Opera. What about the forums?

Our forums will be moving to www.opera.com. The most important existing threads will be moved

across, and you will be able to use your My Opera account to log in and continue the discussion. In other words: Your My Opera account has become your new Opera account that you can use for all Opera services and products. To summarize, what do we suggest you do now?
