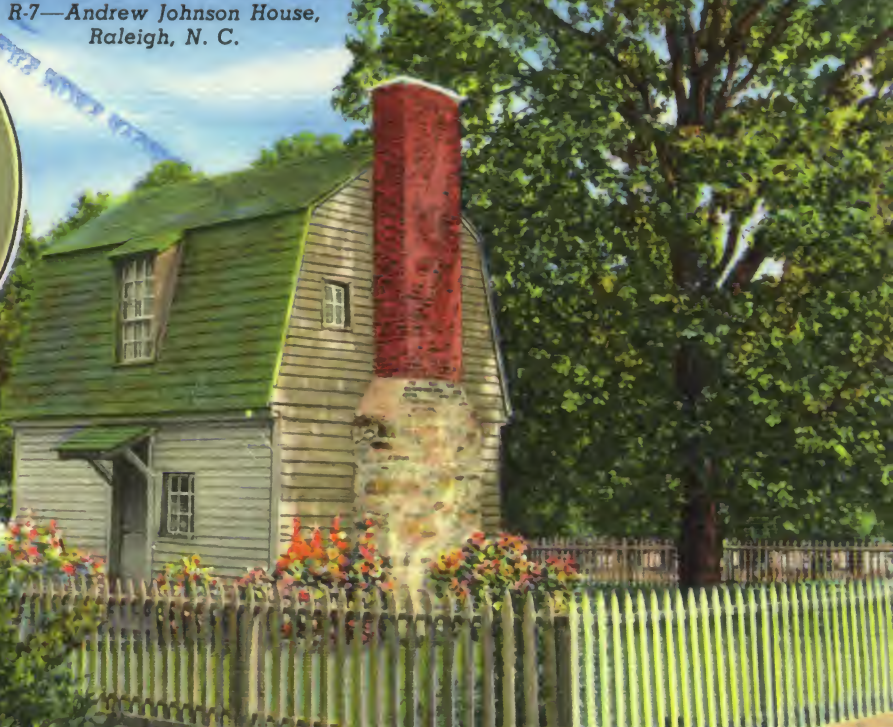

ANDREW JOHNSON HOUSE

Andrew Johnson, the seventeenth president of the United States 1865—1869, was born in Raleigh on Dec. 29, 1808 in this house which now stands on city property adjoining the North Carolina State College campus. The house formerly stood not far from the State Capitol and was moved to its present location in order to preserve it as a historical shrine.
