K mart opens two locations



K mart Corporation will add two new K mart discount department stores to its Houston penetration at 9:30 a.m., tomorrow, March 8th, on W. Nasa Blvd in Webster, and on W. 34th St. in Houston.

When the stores open, K mart will have 18 units in the market area. On the same day, K mart will also make their debuts in Amarillo and Garland bringing the

number of K marts operating in Texas to 97.

The new Webster K mart will be a 68,337 square-foot unit and the Houston store will be 62,132 square feet.

On March 8, 11 other K marts will open throughout the country for a total of 1511 K marts in the United States, Puerto Rico and Canada.

Edward C. Andrews is vice-president for the K mart Corporation's Southern Region. he is responsible for more than 250 K mart and Kresge stores in nine states and Puerto Rico. Andrews' responsibility is supervision of store operations in this region. He works closely with his district managers to see that each store manager tailors the merchandise assortments to meet the shopping needs of local customers. With two locations opening tomorrow in the Houston area, K mart will have a total of 18 units serving the market area. Grand opening festivities will take place at both
