THE TEMPLAR PIRATES: The Secret Alliance to Build the New Jerusalem by Ernesto Frers

Piracy has been around for as long as seafaring and has played its part in the unfolding of history since four millennia ago when Egyptian and Phoenician cargo ships were first targeted. In the sixth century BC, it became an organised method of plundering and subjugating coastal and island peoples in the Aegean and Mediterranean seas.

This is the launching point for mediaeval historian Ernesto Frers, but his prime interest here is in the role of the Knights Templar. The Norman Templar king Roger II of Sicily was the first to fly the so-called Jolly Roger flag (the skull and crossbones) in defiance of the pope in 1127, but it was not until their excommunication by Pope Clement V in 1307 that the Templars turned to maritime piracy in a big way. This was after they received a tip-off ahead of a raid by French king Philip IV's troops and decided to flee their port of La Rochelle. Their divided fleet headed for disparate destinations: Portugal, Scotland and the New World, where, later, with Henry Sinclair's backing, they established colonies in a bid to build a New Jerusalem, free of papist control. Indeed, the Templars' piracy for hundreds of years was part of their secret war against the Holy See, and their efforts were

bolstered by opportunistic buccaneers from the Mediterranean to the Caribbean.

Frers traces the influence of the remnant Templars in the expeditions of Christopher Columbus, Francis Drake and Walter Raleigh as well as French Huguenot buccaneers who started their own libertarian brotherhood. The pirate knights and their brothers also influenced the rise of the revolutionary movements in France and America along with the growth of Freemasonry, four of whose members—Franklin, Jefferson, Adams and Paine—helped to write the US Declaration of Independence. These are fascinating undercurrents with occult offshoots which Frers brings to light, and they present a different picture from "official" history.

THE LORDS OF AVARIS: Uncovering the Legendary Origins of Western Civilisation



The origins of Western civilisation are traditionally sourced in Classical Greece and Rome, cultures that are traceable to the Heroic Age of ancient Minoan Crete, Mycenaean Greece and Trojan Anatolia (Turkey). But what if the myths of minotaurs and labyrinths, Trojan warriors and Cyclopean citadels were not just the stuff of Homeric legend but historical narratives?

Archaeologist David Rohl (*The Lost Testament*, NEXUS 10/02) has managed to bring these myths to life by applying the same New Chronology (NC) he proposed in his 1995 book *A Test of Time*, which gives a radical down-dating of Egyptian history by deleting three centuries of "artificial time"

from the New Kingdom and the Third Intermediate Period. But not only does his NC offer an historical timeline for the Old Testament narratives, it places the Heroic legends in their proper context.

The scene begins in the second millennium BC, following a catastrophe and subsequent famine that destroyed many Middle Eastern cities and ended the Early Bronze Age. It's the time when Indo-European-speaking tribes from the north, who became the Hittites and the later founders of the Greek, Persian and Roman empires, began their invasions of Mesopotamia and Egypt, thus creating a three-way struggle. Starting with the Hyksos who ruled in Avaris in the Nile Delta, Rohl takes the reader on an epic journey through 2,000 years of history, ending with the foundation of Rome by the Trojan hero Aeneas. On the way, among other events he explains the sudden appearance of the Etruscans in Hesperia (Italy). Rohl's superbly illustrated book complements his richly detailed text. A tour de force.





PARALLEL UNIVERSES OF SELF by Frederick E. Dodson

Life is too short to waste time in the head-space of an insignificant, needy person when you can revel in the real you as a multidimensional, eternal being, says "reality-creation coach" Fred Dodson. Based in Germany, he has been teaching creative learning for the last 10 years, and in this, his 16th book, he provides well-honed mental and emotional techniques for exploring reality and consciousness. His first bit of advice is to "go for the real thing"—for experience, not just knowledge for its own sake—and with joy in the process.

Dodson's take on reality creation (RC) is inspired by the latest ways of thinking in frontier science; it's a theory of "parallel universe reality emulation" (PURE), and is more expansive than some "new age" versions of RC that he regards as hindered by egocentric focus and based on a sense of lack and wishful thinking. Surely influenced by ancient Hermetic philosophy with its laws of correspondence and attraction, Dodson says that if like attracts like then lack attracts lack. The shortcut to your heart's desire is being "the version of yourself that is already experiencing that reality", but attachment to that desire isn't the way.

By tapping into the infinite self, however, we don't actually create reality because within infinity everything already exists; thus it doesn't need creating. But that doesn't mean that we can avoid personal responsibility or shirk common sense and intuition, our own "inner authority": we'll never feel fulfilled if we do. He recommends taking time to

become silent and relaxed, and to connect with happiness in the here and now. His own stories about the path of enlightenment are instructive, and much of what he says will give a sense of *déja vu* to fellow seekers. If I had to sum this up, I'd say you'll never get from A to B as long as you maintain the distance. Just *be* there!

COURAGEOUS SOULS: Do We Plan Our Life Challenges Before Birth? by Robert Schwartz

Four years ago, marketing consultant Robert Schwartz set out to explore the meaning of life and decided to visit a medium. She explained that we all have spirit guidesnoncorporeal and nonjudgemental beings whom we consult when we plan our lives in between incarnations—but we also have free will. Schwartz went through a reawakening process and soon afterwards had an enhanced communication with his soul in an experience where he felt unconditional love for everyone. This set him on a path to ascertain why he'd pre-planned certain learning experiences in his life. The result of his questing is this book.

Schwartz recruited the assistance of four mediums and channels and posted messages on Internet bulletin boards, seeking feedback from individuals keen to explore any underlying difficulties they've faced in life. Dozens of people were involved in this prebirth-planning study, and the stories of 10

"courageous souls" were chosen for inclusion. With the help of the psychics, they delved into issues to do with physical illness and disability, handicapped children, drug and alcohol addiction, accidents and deaths. Each case is presented with notes from the psychic readings where the spirit guides were contacted. Despite their difficulties, each person came to understand that their "life script" was agreed upon and motivated by love and the opportunity for soul growth fostered by learning through hard knocks.

Their stories and their resolutions are deeply moving and make us wonder whether we have indeed set ourselves up for tragedy and triumph in order to progress our own evolution and that of others. We are left feeling heartened by the prospect that we can tap into our soul space and transform anger, guilt and blame into love, forgiveness and acceptance. Schwartz's research is a life-affirming exercise that shows we direct our soul learning and aren't hapless victims of the vagaries of fate.



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HOW TO SWAP ASTHMA FOR LIFE by Michael Clark, NMQAA

That the UK alone has five million diagnosed cases of asthma and 18,000 new cases each week is cause for great concern, and UK Buteyko practitioner Michael Clark is determined to do something about it. In fact, he met Prof. Buteyko, developer of the scientifically based breathing technique that overcomes "overbreathing", just months before he died in 2003 and promised to spread the word about the technique.

In his book, Clark gives a brief history of asthma before describing the different types of asthma and their triggers, which can include allergens such as animal dander, pollen and dust mite dirt, airborne pollutants, perfumes, bacteria, poor diet (e.g., too much acidifying rather than alkalising food), stress and even fear. He then discusses the conventional asthma medications and their side effects, and follows up with information about Buteyko's treatment and the science of respiration and breathing.

In the following sections, Clark explains some essential breathing and posture techniques that have been used successfully in teaching asthmatics how to breathe properly without hyperventilating. This condition causes a depletion of carbon dioxide in the lungs, which causes the blood vessels to spasm and tissues to be starved of oxygen. The Buteyko breathing method restores balance to the respiratory system.

Next, Clark looks at other alternative asthma treatments from acupuncture to yoga, and hints at why your GP may not have heard of the drug-free Buteyko technique.

Finally, he outlines a code of conduct that holistic Buteyko practitioners must abide by; this constitutes useful advice, too, for the client in selecting the right teacher.

A Q&A section, a paper on the theoretical premises of the Buteyko Method and a glossary cap off this very informative book.

THE INTENTION EXPERIMENT by Lynne McTaggart



In the follow-up to her book *The Field* (see NEXUS 8/06), London-based health and spirituality author Lynne McTaggart explores what shamans and mystics have known since time immemorial: that thoughts are things with a tangible energy and can exert influence on other things for good or ill, thus affecting physical reality. Furthermore, the power of thought, or intention, can transcend time and space.

Experiments into the so-called "observer" effect in quantum physics were stepped up over 30 years ago to test "directed remote" mental influence" and "intentionality", and here McTaggart highlights some landmark scientific research illustrating how intention works, how it can be used in one's life, and the conditions that optimise its effect. Tom Rosenbaum and Sayantani Ghosh's work with "mutable" crystals, Cleve Backster's research on plants and cell cultures reacting to human intent, Elisabeth Targ and Marilyn Schitz's "Love Study" on the effect of "remote staring", Stanley Krippner's research into brain coherence of indigenous and spiritual healers, and Mitch Krucoff and Suzanne Crater's "MANTRA" studies of directed prayer groups are just some of the

frontier science that is changing our understanding of consciousness and reality.

McTaggart introduces her own exciting experiment in which readers can participate after completing her practical program of "intention exercises" designed to aid meditation, visualisation and focus of intent. She's set up a website, http://www.theintention experiment.com, to allow participants to link up to focus the collective power of positive intention on specific targets, e.g., in remote healing of individuals, clearing pollution or generally helping make the planet a better place with more compassionate people. She has the support of consciousness scientists Brenda Dunne and Robert Jahn of the PEAR lab at Princeton University and Fritz-Albert Popp and colleagues at the International Institute for Biophysics in Germany in designing experimental protocols and analysing the results of each experiment.

It will be interesting to see more proof that the power of our thoughts, intentions, imagery and actions *can* change the world.





THE ARK, THE SHROUD, AND MARY by Philip Gardiner

Philip Gardiner has spent years studying esoteric art and literature, making contacts with members of secret societies and travelling the world in search of answers to some of the great mysteries of history.

While in Winchester Cathedral, England, looking for images to use in his previous book *Gnosis* (see 13/02), he had an insight about similarities in symbolism in the reliefs on show, perceiving a link between Mary, (the mother of Jesus), the Ark of the Covenant and the Shroud of Turin that some might regard as far-fetched. The story that emerged for him concerns the loss of the Old Covenant and the emergence of the New Covenant or Testimony with the resurrection of Christ from the tomb or Ark.

Gardiner has looked further into the Ark tradition and found evidence of it in Egypt, Mesopotamia and India, where the festival of Jagganath—its centrepiece a large arktype vehicle—is still celebrated at the Purishrine in Orissa state. These ancient civilisations also had their goddesses, and Gardiner wondered whether Mary was a Christian version of the Egyptian Isis. But what was her connection with the Ark?

After analysing the myths and etymology associated with the Ark, Gardiner believes it was a "repository" or "vessel" protecting the Divine light of wisdom—and so, too, was Mary who (as the myth goes) gave birth to the Divine child who grew within her. Similarly, the Shroud of Turin could be a repository of the Divine light, released by

Christ while in a state of ecstatic enlightenment as a burst of photonic energy.

The hidden message Gardiner discerns is that God is to be found within each of us: we are the vessels carrying the Divine light. The way to tapping it starts with learning to balance our desires and developing compassion. Gardiner's book informs and inspires.


In the process of preparing the first English translation of Otto Rahn's influential 1933 book *Kreuzzug gegen den Gral* ("Crusade against the Grail"), historical scholar Christopher Jones retraced Rahn's footsteps through the caves and castles of the former Cathar territory of southern France.

Based on his reading of Eschenbach's mediaeval chivalric epic Parzival as an historical account, Rahn saw the Cathars as the last custodians of the Grail-not the Holy Grail or cup of the blood of Christ, but a "stone from the stars". In his book, Rahn develops the Grail into an icon for the survival of the soul—an emblem for the unseen. The beliefs of the Cathars stemmed from ancient Druidism with a dose of Gnosticism and Manichaeism from the East. Their philosophy was based on the Minneideal, sublime love—as the law, and it was practised most diligently by the "Pure Ones", spread by the troubadours and supported by the knights and the people.

Rahn points out that most of the Cathar

writings and, indeed, their culture, were wiped out during the Albigensian Crusade, commencing with the destruction of Béziers in 1209 and continuing till 1229, covering the regions of Languedoc and Provence. Hundreds of thousands of "heretics" to Roman Church doctrines were wiped out by the popes and their minions. However, Rahn managed to piece together a good modicum of their history from extant records and from descendants of survivors. His accounts of the demise of the Cathars are truly shocking, and perhaps Rahn was trying to make sense of his own troubled times in the light of these bloody massacres.

A top German archaeologist and Grail historian, Rahn caught the attention of Heinrich Himmler soon after publication of his book and was induced to assist the Nazis in their explorations into ancient civilisations and treasures. Disillusioned, in 1939 Rahn died in a ritual Cathar style, allegedly committing suicide. His work lives on and contributes a warning about the dangers of extremism that's as true now as in his day.





IN SEARCH OF QUETZALCOATL by Pierre Honoré

Many ancient peoples of Central and
South America left behind records of a
bearded "white god" who brought civilisation to their tribes. He was Quetzalcoatl to
the Toltecs and Aztecs, Viracocha to the
Inca, and Kukulcan to the Maya.

French researcher Pierre Honoré, whose highly illustrated book on the mysterious heritage of American civilisation was published in 1961, travelled extensively in South and Central America when he was based in Brazil as a government adviser and director of a research institute. In the course of his 15-year investigations of ancient cultural remnants, he observed many parallels with ancient Mediterranean cultures as well as Chinese influences that arrived via the Pacific, causing a cultural explosion in Peru and Bolivia with the Chavin civilisation from around 1000 BC. Later outpourings of Cambodian, Indian and Javanese cultures can be seen in Toltec and Mayan architecture. But it was Mediterranean influences-Minoan and perhaps Phoenician—that were responsible for the bearded white god legends and artefacts, Honoré believed. In a foray up an Amazon tributary, guided by tribal youth with knowledge of the "white god", he rediscovered stones bearing an ancient script of Phoenician source.

Particularly notable was his research into the similarity between Mayan glyphs and the Minoans' original pictorial script, used until around 1700 BC. Honoré reasoned the script had to have been transferred to the New World by that date; but if it took another 1,500 years for the Mayan civilisation to emerge, then the script had to have been nurtured by an older, as yet unknown, civilisation probably based in the Amazon Valley, where some native peoples of fair skin and hair were still known to live.

While much more has been uncovered since Honoré did his research, his book has laid essential groundwork for getting to the heart of the Mesoamerican mysteries.

GENESIS OF MAN by June Austin



In combining her knowledge of pre- and ancient history with mythology and spiritual philosophy, Surrey-based Reiki master and crystal therapist June Austin speculates in *Genesis of Man* on who we are, where we came from and where we're heading.

Austin presents evidence for an alternative celestial heritage where the first humans were seeded by extraterrestrial "gods" who returned from time to time to instruct the fledgling *Homo sapiens*. Information about the solar system, for instance—as can be seen in ancient clay seals—was passed on by the Nephilim, part angelic souls from another world, Nibiru, to the ancient Sumerians of Mesopotamia. These were a people whose civilisation *seemed* to "spring from nowhere", as did that of the Egyptians, the Maya and perhaps even the Atlanteans. However, some of what Austin suggests about civilisations of prehistory and other

matters is sourced from the realm of channelling, which can't be considered reliable.

Nor can more recent records in the Gospels be considered "Gospel truth", and Austin admits this, relating examples of inconsistencies between these four books, yet she devotes many pages to alternative takes on what are undoubtedly forged holy books but coded with esoteric messages. Influenced by the famous "Course in Miracles", Austin makes the case for our being souls interconnected with the Divine source, our role in this world being to learn to balance the light and the dark within ourselves. The more aware we are of our Divine heritage, the more connected we are with humanity as a whole and the more able we are to exercise forgiveness and compassion to our fellow man. The way home comes by getting in touch with the silence within, not by blind faith in a priesthood or religious buildings and ceremonies. (I'd have liked to seen a closing chapter that draws all these threads together, but maybe that's in the second edition that's being printed as we go to press.)





A GAME AS OLD AS EMPIRE: The Secret World of Economic Hit Men and the Web of Global Corruption edited by Steven Hiatt

When former "economic hit man" ("EHM") John Perkins came clean in 2004 about his past as an agent for the "corporatocracy", bringing developing nations to their knees, he was somewhat stunned by corporate media's lack of interest in his book, *Confessions of an Economic Hit Man*. This only proved his point about corporate interests protecting their own. Pressed to prove that this secret global empire actually existed, Perkins and his publisher set about commissioning this compilation, appointing editor and activist Steven Hiatt to the task.

The result, A Game As Old As Empire, is a collection of essays by former EHMs, jour-



nalists and activists who are just as keen to expose the fact that corporations, governments, financial institutions and international agencies enrich their coffers under the guise of "foreign aid" and "international development". Perkins leads with new revelations about the dark side of globalisation, and Hiatt is next with his views on the Global Empire's web of control, where the Global South subsidises the wealthy North.

A dozen others speak out: former banker Sam Gwynne on setting the debt trap; exoffshore banker John Christiensen on laundering dirty money flows; Lucy Komisar on the BCCI's double game; Kathleen Kern on the human cost of cheap cellphones (coltan vs the Congolese); Andrew Rowell and James Marriott on mercenaries protecting corporate interests on the African front lines; and Gregg Muttitt on EHMs' hijacking of Iraq's oil reserves. But there's more...

Former World Bank staffer Steve Berkman explains how the debt-based development strategy diverts money into the hands of the corrupt elite; Ellen Augustine reveals how

the World Bank financed martial law under Marcos; Bruce Rich uncovers the secretive world of export credit agencies (ECAs) and the social, economic and environmental damage they wreak around the world; and James S. Henry unveils the mirage of debt relief, where poor countries are forced to close hospitals and schools, and he suggests steps for an effective debt relief campaign.

Antonia Juhasz (*The Bush Agenda*) has the final say with her piece on the global web of resistance that in recent years has been making a dent against exploitation and introducing strategies that promote social justice and empowerment. This is a call to action!

THE CHILLING STARS: A New Theory of Climate Change

Tust when you thought the carbon dioxid

Just when you thought the carbon dioxide theory of global warming was gaining the upper hand, along comes a theory that puts the Sun back into the equation and introduces cosmic rays and clouds. *The Chilling Stars* is a collaboration between Henrik Svensmark, of the Danish National Space Centre, and Nigel Calder, science writer and editor of *New Scientist* in the 1960s.

Ten years of research by Svensmark shows that cosmic rays, sourced from exploding stars, play a part in making clouds here on Earth, but that, in the last 100 years, increasing levels of solar activity have deflected more and more of these rays, resulting in fewer clouds and a warmer planet. Studies of Greenland and Antarctic ice cores as well as seabed cores show that our climate is cyclical and goes through warming and cooling phases; indeed, it can even go through warming during times of glaciation.

Only last year, Svensmark was able to demonstrate in the lab that cosmic rays, of the highly energetic muon variety, have enough velocity to approach sea level and, because they are charged, liberate electrons and act as building blocks of condensation nuclei on which water droplets form to produce clouds in the lower atmosphere. When the Sun is in a less active phase, more of these muons can penetrate our atmosphere and form more clouds, radiating more heat into space. As well, cosmic ray bombardments differ in magnitude depending on the location of the solar system in its path through the Milky Way; when we cross the galactic mid-plane, cosmic rays are stronger and the Earth goes through a cooling cycle.

Before you make up your mind about the causes of climate change, you're advised to read this controversial, compelling book.



HOW TO START YOUR OWN SECRET SOCIETY by Nick Harding

His tongue often firmly in cheek, Nick Harding carries off this guide to starting your own secret society with aplomb while being quite serious about the subject. With this book, I'm reminded of the Monty Python sketch where the John Cleese character lashes out at the Freemason architects who wouldn't let him join their fraternity. Here are tips for come-uppance against the nefarious powers that be, whether they be at local, national or global level, and many opportunities for creative participation.

As you'll see in these pages, many revolutionary movements got their impetus at the local pub or coffee house. Some were more successful than others, and Harding gives



pointers on how to maintain secrecy, create special communication codes including passwords and handshakes, and deal with the inevitable political intrigue that results from, well, having a secret society. Some societies of the past were actually satires on the really secret societies of their times, which is heartening in that this confirms humour's long history as an antidote to oppression. So, with this considered advice, you're encouraged to let rip with your wishes for local dominion or global domination.

Harding acknowledges input from Masonic brothers who have enlightened him as to the workings of their secretive ceremonies. These notes proffer essential background information if you want to create your own inner sanctum and confound your potential detractors. There are tips on what to look for in conspiracy theorists to head them off at the pass, and notes on requirements as a member of such high-profile groups as the Knights Templar, Illuminati, Opus Dei and the Freemasons. An amusing diversion with snippets of truth.

GHOST PLANE: The Untold Story of the CIA's Torture Programme by Stephen Grey

The expression "extraordinary rendition" describes the capture of suspected terrorists and transfer by CIA-hired private jets to foreign prisons and secret detention facilities for interrogation and torture. Journalist Stephen Grey headed the UK *Sunday Times Insight* investigation team when, in the USA soon after 9/11, he first heard of these transfers and then set about obtaining the logs of these new-style "Air America" CIA flights.

Grey went public in May 2004 in an article for the New Statesman, and in time has collected about 12,000 records for over 20 planes that transported prisoners to a range of countries cooperating with the US Bush administration in its "war on terror", including Egypt, Syria, Jordan, Afghanistan, Uzbekhistan, Morocco and Thailand, most of which had no problems with their military secret police torturing detainees held without charge. Yet even in December 2005, US Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice claimed the US would never transport prisoners to places where they'd be tortured, and British PM Tony Blair denied there was evidence of any illegal conduct.

In *Ghost Plane*, Grey spills the beans on the CIA's extraordinary rendition program as well as the Pentagon's role in mass renditions via US military transport planes. Indeed, there's nothing new about these renditions: the US has been carrying them out for decades but stepped up activities in response to 9/11. Grey has been able to pin down 89 renditions since then (listed in the appendix), but he suspects that several thousand individuals have been imprisoned. In fact, the Guantánamo Bay renditions are just the tip of the iceberg, he maintains.

While the majority of prisoners are still unaccounted for, some have been released on no charges and their desperate stories are recounted here, along with testimony on and off the record from CIA pilots, operations officers and chiefs as well as White House officials who knew that torture was inevitable in these foreign prisons.

Grey recounts in the third part of his book the international public backlash against these renditions and the involvement of so-called democratic governments in facilitating them. All the while, the Bush administration wants to continue these covert extralegal practices. This is a chilling exposé that, it's hoped, will help turn the tables.

The Electric Model is surely our next step in understanding how the cosmos works.






Engineer John Hutchison is also interviewed and, as usual, he has some amazing things to say about gravity
