Asthma Linked to Vaccinations

Dear Duncan: Congratulations on your continued good work.

I wanted to comment on one article in particular in the 6/05 edition—that by Dr Paul J. Ameisen, on the Buteyko method of dealing with asthma. Whilst well done, it failed to note one major underlying causal factor for asthma: that of vaccines.

For example, in one study in the UK it was found that children vaccinated against whooping cough were six times more likely to have asthma as those who hadn't been given the jab. This figures, because the DPT shot has been found to damage (through demyelination) cranial nerve systems, including those governing respiration. Thus, the over-breathing characteristic of asthma is an attempt to overcome the defence mechanisms of the body in responding to the stress and damage occasioned by the vaccination shots.

There has also been a link noted between asthma and the bacterium *Chlamydia pneumoniae*. Infection with this bug appears to trigger an inflammatory reaction which then predisposes babies and children to asthma. But, as with ear infections, also extremely common in babies and children these days, it is a matter of what came first.

With vaccines known for suppressing the immune system (occupied fighting their toxic load) and for triggering inflammatory reactions (that is their job, in order to stimulate the production of antibodies, occasioning other autoimmune conditions as well), it's no wonder that various bugs chronically take root in their wake. No wonder except, apparently, to the allopathic medical profession—which is another story...

In any event, this answers the question of why so much asthma is being triggered, and has been triggered in the last 50 years—a period precisely coinciding with the advent of mass vaccination programs. Seen in conjunction with other epidemic conditions in this same time-period, denoting various forms of brain damage—ADD/ADHD, dyslexia, autism, anorexia/bulimia, bipolar disorder, OCD, etc., etc.—the vaccination connection begins to become

clearer...for those who have eyes to see, that is.

As for tidal wave prognostications and such: keep breathing; just don't hyperventilate.

More "AIDS" Fallacies

Dear Editor: I was delighted to read the article by Val Turner and Andrew McIntyre in the June-July 1999 issue of NEXUS [6/04, Part 1]. "AIDS" is perhaps the biggest medical hoax of the century (if not many centuries), and I hope you find space in future issues to cover more on this subject.

Val Turner is well known to me and a frequent correspondent, and therefore knows my views regarding anal sex and "AIDS", so he will not be surprised that I take exception to his reference to this subject in his paper as well as to the reliability of Michael Callen's anecdotal statements regarding his sex life which supposedly killed him (2nd page, col. 1).

The authors state (5th page, col. 1): "Consistent also with the Eleopulos oxidative stress theory is the direct relationship between high frequencies of passive anal intercourse and the development of AIDS, as well as the fact that the only animal model of AIDS is non-infectious. Mice repeatedly injected with foreign cellular proteins [read sperm] develop a dramatic depletion of T4 cells and Kaposi's sarcoma-like tumours..."

The fact is that there is no correlation between "AIDS" and anal intercourse—which I revealed in my paper, "Anal Sex and AIDS" (*Continuum*, London, vol. 4, no. 4, Nov-Dec 1996, pp. 18-19). In this brief paper, I give data which indicate that anal sex is so ubiquitous in the human population, being practised in large numbers by heterosexuals, that any correlation with "AIDS" is impossible.

For example, in an article by Voeller (*AIDS and Sex*, Oxford University Press, 1990, p. 283), we can read that "In a survey of some 5,000 households, over 40% of those interviewed in rural Brazil considered anal intercourse a normal part of sexuality [emphasis mine], and over 50% of urban citizens in Rio de Janeiro did..." These astounding figures for heterosexuals are not generally known...

Incidentally, the counting of T4 cells in no way is a correlation with illness and is another fallacy which Dr Turner interjects to make his correlation. Before the "AIDS" construct, T4 cell counts had been totally discarded as indicating anything at all. They fluctuate wildly in individuals, and Dr Turner is only taking the CDC's line to prove his point on this issue. It is a specious argument. Many athletes and perfectly normal people have low T4 cell counts.

In the animal model referred to in the quotation above, it would appear that "Kaposi sarcoma-like tumours" are not the same as the true Kaposi's sarcoma which is diagnosed in "AIDS" patients and is invariably linked to the use of nitrite inhalers. It is a true cancer...

The evidence, therefore, would seem to point to drugs of all kinds, which is what Dr Peter Duesberg has been saying all along.

What, then, is the only thing that is new to the scene? Drugs! In the interview with Michael Callen, he is portrayed as having come down with "AIDS" because of his libertine lifestyle alone. This is a partial truth. The whole truth is that those who knew him have revealed that he was a heavy user of amyl nitrite (poppers) and other recreational drugs. I can also tell you that his diet was abominable. I heard him lecture in San Francisco and he urged those with "AIDS" to eat whole boxes of chocolates if they wished. In addition to all that, he was taking copious quantities of prescription drugs for his "AIDS" condition. That alone is enough to kill off anyone.

I lived through that period, also, and contracted most of the diseases (not all listed are necessarily venereal) that Callen did. I did, however, always eat well and exercise, and never used hard drugs such as poppers and cocaine.

The conclusion of most of us who have thought deeply about this situation is that about 95 per cent of all "AIDS" cases have been caused iatrogenically (i.e., by prescription drugs). Michael Callen might have survived, as I have, if he had eaten right, not taken the prescribed drugs and not

used recreational drugs.

That, in my mind, is the true story. At 70 years of age, I am living proof that one can live through such an experience. I am not advocating going back to that kind of lifestyle, but, in the end, one creates one's own destiny both physically and spiritually.

I have still the highest regard for the Perth group and its pioneering work on "AIDS", with only these minor differences. Their work on exposing the total hoax of African "AIDS" is superb, as is their work on the very existence of HIV.

MTBE and Unleaded Fuels

Dear Sir: I am very concerned about the effects of MTBE seeping through the ground and into our water supplies. There have been reports of this happening in California, and many people who did not know the dangers of unleaded fuel, do so now.

I added my two bits some time back when I wrote Layton Black at the Texas Capitol building at Austin, Texas, about how I felt with the use of unleaded fuel. I thought it was dangerous then, and I believe it's dangerous now.

When I was a mechanic working in New Zealand, we converted a great deal of large American and Canadian cars to run on CNG or LPG, with very good results. We did a 1967 Impala with V8 and 2-bbl carburettor, and achieved almost 30 mpg with only a negligible loss in engine power. Had we in the US adopted these two alternative fuels, we could have still kept our large, luxury cars with the added bonus of the mpg—which some cars today are struggling to meet. We do have some vehicles here on CNG or LPG, but nowhere near enough.

If they take MTBE out of the unleaded fuel, I do wonder what they will replace it with. If it cannot be done successfully, and we cannot raise the octane rating safely, I can see the return of larg-

er, low-compression engines running on "pool" petrol. The modern, small, high-output engines will not have the cubic capacity to handle the job.
