All lots are carefully attributed, guaranteed genuine, and grade will be found as noted.

Be sure to enter on bid sheet correct lot number and BID BY LOT IN ALL CASES. List prices after each item represent the present value of the lots listed. They are not reserve prices, and you must use your own judgment what you wish to bid.

BUY bids will be accepted and carried out as far as possible. I prefer that you place a limit on same, due to the unusual market that now prevails. UNLIMITED bids insure your getting the coin, at a few cents over the next. highest bids.

The terms of this sale are cash promptly on receipt of goods. Remit in whatever way is most convenient. Successful bidders will be notified immediately after sale and coins shipped at once, if credit references are O.K. There is no charge for executing bids, but postage on shipments is added to invoice. I frequently put invoice in with parcel of coins. If your bids are not successful, you will always receive a post card immediately notifying you of that fact.

If you are bidding for the first time, put references on back of bid sheet. If you have bid at my sales and failed to secure the items desired, write me and I will be glad to look up your sheet and tell you where the trouble is. There is much to learn in making bids at mail auction sales.

You are much more likely to be successful in a strictly mail sale than one where a public auction is held the last day, as any one on the floor can bid a few cents over your mail bid and secure the lot. Often a 10 cent bid will lose the item, where you might have been glad to have it at the increased price. It is always a very good idea to bid what you feel you can afford.

## Numismatic Chatter

Every issue of my catalogue goes to approximately 100 people who have not received it before. If you have never bought coins from an auction, it is a good time to start. Read instructions in front of book and then fill out bid sheet for the items you would like to buy. The values printed after each item are what the coins sell for in a first-class coin shop and there is usually no discount from same.

The new Standard Catalogue for 1945 I understand is in press and may be ready before my next auction lists are mailed. If you wish me to send you a copy with bill as soon as issued, give me this information on your bid sheet. It is the very best investment any coin collector can make. I use it every day of my life and no amount of money could induce me to be without it.

The set of Indian Head Proofs in my last sale all went to one bidder, but I filled a very few other bids on single items from some in my stock. Very sorry I did not have more. The bid was $5 \%$ over any other bidder. I frequently receive such bids on single items but only rarely on an entire set.

Proofs usually sold for full list or more. Only a few of the more common proofs sold as low at $90 \%$ of list price. The proofs and many other items will likely be advanced in the 1945 book and my estimates of values in next catalogue are likely to be higher than in this.

One bidder on foreign gold received $\$ 2,246.10$, the largest single consignment I have shipped on any auction but he only received a part of what he bid on, as others bid higher. Still I wish to compliment him on his good judgment, in these unusual times.

Another bidder who sent a bid on every gold coin I listed in the book received only a few pieces. He evidently thought my estimates of value were too high and hence lost out on about all the items he bid on. I have had no end of letters from experienced collectors, on the honesty of my list values.

Notwithstanding all the information I have given patrons the past ten years approximately one-third of all bidders do not get a coin on their bids. This is due to a great variety of reasons and perhaps cannot be helped but I do like to ship each bidder something if only one coin. Still I cannot do so if they pay little or no attention to the printed value of the coins.

As I am listing in this book a complete set of commemorative half dollars and carry no stock of them myself I could likely sell several hundred duplicates, on duplicate bids. There are 77 numbers in the list and I will likely have 500 to a 1,000 bids. If you have some duplicates send them to me at once, not over five of any one date or variety and I will sell them for you at only $10 \%$ of sale price. You receive much more than any dealer would pay.

During the past two years I have distributed to my patrons an average of $\$ 3,000$ cash on every auction. This is for coins sent me to sell. I sell all Unc, Proof USA and all gold and rare coins at $10 \%$. A rare coin is one that sells for $\$ 25$ or over. All other coins are $20 \%$ but I will not list a lot of very cheap material. Better write me at once what you have to spare. Liberal advance payments if needed.

Collectors who send me material to sell frequently send me a strictly confidential list of names of people they know who might like to buy some of the material they are selling. All dealings are strictly confidential and no patrons receives any publicity. Write me today before you forget it.
