Northampton welcomed the stars of Manchester United - both past and present - as millions of football fans from around the world tuned in to watch the Cobblers take on the giants of the Premier League. A record crowd of 7,798 supporters

packed Sixfields to watch the EFL Cup third round game, with Sky Sports and beIN Sports cameras broadcast-ing to viewers across Europe, America, Africa and the Middle East.

Hundreds also gathered on the hill-side overlooking the stadium for a free if somewhat restricted view of the action.

United legend Sir Bobby Charlton graced the main stand, and former defender Phil Neville took his spot in the makeshift Sky Sports studio.

The former Cobblers manager and

the hero of last season Chris Wilder was also taking part in the punditry. Before the first kick of the game, a hotel in Daventry bizarrely found itself in the national news after a pic-ture of the Manchester United team training in the hotel's car park

appeared on social media. Jose Mourinho's squad had arrived at the Daventry Court Hotel and Spa the night before, where they had dinner and stayed the night. The next morning, the team were spotted training in the car park of the four-

star hotel, with Zlatan Ibrahomovic and Wayne Rooney among the stars. While the image went viral on social media, home and away fans were already descending on Sixfields sta-dium in the afternoor to cook up the dium in the afternoon to soak up the atmosphere and get their hands on a special edition 84-page programme, which the club had to order thousands more of due to the 'huge demand' in pre-orders.

Nearby restaurants such as McDonald's also had to lay on extra staff and order more food, while



# Hearing dog a hero again

A hearing dog is being hailed a hero once again - after leading his owner to a stranger who had collapsed, while the pair were on holiday.

Golden retriever loe has been specially trained by Hearing Dogs for Deaf People to assist Matthew Lunney, a profoundly deaf man originally from Northampton but who now lives in Wellingborough.

Last year the dog was presented with a heroic award for scaring away a robber who tried to break into Matt's car while both were inside it.

But now Joe is being called a hero for the second time, after performing life-saving actions while in Weston-Super-Mare. Matt said Joe woke him up in the

morning wanting a walk and while they were out the dog ran

off barking, before returning to Matt and guiding him to a collapsed stranger.

"When Joe stopped, I saw that a lady had fallen down the steps, and wasn't moving," Matt said. "There was no signal on my phone so Joe instinctively stayed with her whilst I ran back to my car and pressed the SOS button.

"Twenty minutes later the paramedics arrived. The lady was badly hurt, in tears, and emotional. She kept asking me 'how did you get help?'. As she got into the ambulance, the paramedics were telling her about Joe. She realised if it hadn't been for him, she would not have been found.

Speaking about how proud he is of Joe, Matt added: "He is a special dog, one in a million and I wouldn't dream of leaving him or swapping him. He is my loyal dedicated ears and amazing hearing dog hero."



# Mum victim of road rage

A mum-of-two has spoken for the first time about her 10 minutes of verbal abuse and intimidation at the hands of a 'boy racer'.

Stacey Dunkley suffered a barrage of abuse, hand gestures and what she felt was inconsiderate and poor driving from the man all the way from Mereway to the Sixfields area of Northampton. Stacey also had her two children, aged six and eight, in the car at the time plus the family cat which they were taking to the vets

Stacey said: "It all started when I was approaching the traffic lights by the roundabout at Mereway and a car pulled in front of me without warning and I had to slam the brakes on. "I beeped the driver and what

followed was totally out of all proportion and ridiculous. "He did a series of hand gestures out of the window, kept braking his car as I was driving

braking his car as I was driving along behind him and swerving across the road to stop me going past him. "At the time I was in the car with my two children, my daughter who is six and my son who is eight, as we were taking the cat to

an appointment at the vets. "I felt very scared and made sure I had locked the doors. My daughter was in tears and very upset by what was happening. This made me even more cross as I had got my children in the car with me. The only reason I was filming it was I had a dashcam in the car.

"I have had one since I had an accident with an uninsured driver and as a result I decided I would be careful and film any journey I went on.

"On this occasion I am glad I did. I think for me it did feel worse when it was all over as at the time I did not know what was going to happen. I was thinking 'why was he doing this'? 'What gives him the right to do this'?" Stacey added she had called the

Stacey added she had called the police about the incident and spent a day downloading the video before sending it off to them.

She was told by an officer the best they could do would be to send the individual a letter about the incident.

# Cop knew of pitbull before it killed baby

A Northants Police officer failed to act after being tipped-off about a banned dog which went on to kill a six-month-old baby, a watchdog report has concluded. Molly-Mae Wotherspoon died from severe blood loss after being attacked by an American pitbull

attacked by an American pitbull called Bruiser at her family home in Daventry in October 2014. The baby's mother, 23-year-old Claire Riley, was jailed for two years at Northampton Crown Court last Thursday, after admmitting owning a danger-ously out of control dog. And the baby's grandmother, Susan Aucott, 56 - who had been babysitting Molly-Mae at Ms Riley's home at the time of the attack - was given the same

attack - was given the same sentence for being in charge of the dog. Both will service half their jail terms on licence.

Following the sentencing -which came after two previous hearings had to be adjourned due to health complications relating to Ms Riley's current pregnancy a report was released by the Independent Police Complaints Commission, looking into how the police handled intelligence



JAIL: Claire Riley and Susan Aucott about the dog. It concluded that a 'PC Claire Paul' has a case to

answer for misconduct. It stated that concerns about Bruiser's aggression had been documented nine months before the attack when Ms Riley took the dog to see a vet.

The vet passed on details about the dog to RSPCA inspector Michelle McNab, who was told by the vet Bruiser was 'extremely aggressive' and 'she had concerns for children in the same house'.

And when the vet suspected it was an American pitbull, which is banned under the Dangerous Dogs Act, she passed information about the dog's aggression to PC Paul, but it was logged as 'low priority' intelligence. The details were then passed on

to another officer for action, but the report says the email may have been accidently deleted and PC Paul did not follow up this request.



A Second World War aircraft suffered minor damage after crashing at an airfield.

# Spray is linked to severe infections

Anyone who has had a body piercing Anyone who has had a body piercing is being urged not to use this spray (pictured), after nine people across the county developed 'serious infections' along with dozens more

across the country. Some 26 patients have fallen ill in recent weeks with a severe infection called Pseudomonas aeruginosa, after using the aftercare bottle which has been distributed widely across the UK

The bacteria can lead to pneumonia, tissue damage or even septic shock in vulnerable people whose immune systems are weakened. As a result, Public Health England

has issued a warning urging people to stop using the product and, if they start showing symptoms, to seek medical help. The product is a 100ml bottled

aftercare saline spray and is manufactured by Lion Care Products Ltd. However, there is no consistent brand or label being used on the product.

So far all the infections have been ear infections, with most occurring in the East Midlands and the South East

There is a grace, skill and an art to flying a jet fighter which very few of us will ever understand. Those who fly these multi-

million pound aircraft in the Royal Air Force (RAF) do so in what they call being 'in the bubble'.

This means they are concentrating on what they are doing and what their mission is but also making an escape plan and thinking 'what happens if this goes wrong'. We can watch in admira-

tion and perhaps guess at the sense of excitement and adrenaline rush it gives the pilot but we will never truly know.

The best way to find out is to ask. The pilot I spoke to is Red Bull Air Race ace Ben Murphy who is from Northamptonshire.

Ben is in his first season in the Red Bull Air Race Challenger Cup and while this is a series of races for what could be called 'novices' at this level. Ben is not a novice when it comes to flying. He first gained his pilot's licence when he was 17, in other words he could legally fly a plane before he

could drive a car. Ben gained his pilot's licence as he was being sponsored by the RAF while he was still at school and he then joined the RAF in 1997 and finished his fly-ing training in 2000.

Ing training in 2000. He went on to become a Harrier GR7 pilot and instructor from 2000 to 2006, flying operationally in Iraq and Afghanistan, where he was awarded campaign medals by both the United Kingdom and United States.

Speaking about his time as a fighter pilot in the RAF, Ben said: "What I was doing had real consequences as when I was flying the Harrier GR7 it was as very close air

support and this included dropping weapons for the troops. I could not afford to make any mistakes as there is no room for error.

"Being a pilot I would say was concentrating 50 per cent on what you were doing and then the other 50 per cent on what you needed to do if something happened. It was knowing how you

would react." In 2006 Ben joined the Red Arrows aerobatic unit as a team pilot, and was promoted to commanding officer and team leader – the second youngest ever to have held that top role. To get into the Red Arrows

fly in the Red Bull Air Race Challenger Cup. Speaking of his new role, he said: "This is a very different step. I have lots of transferable skills which I can bring from flying the Harrier GR7 and being in the Red Arrows to this role.



#### Apartment with old school appeal?

TRENDY nightspot The Hacienda ended up a mecca for clubbers looking to party hard, but the former boat showroom had an unusual opening night back in 1982 with old-school comedian Bernard Manning on the bill.

During its early years, plenty of big hitters lined up to play there, including Culture Club, Simple Minds and The Smiths. It was even the venue for Madonna's first UK performance in 1984. By the end of the decade the Manchester club had achieved cult status as the acid house craze took off, but after drug dealers moved in, the club voluntarily shut for three months and improved security. However, it wasn't enough and The Hacienda finally closed its doors in 1997.

At an end-of-an-era auction fans queued to buy bricks and bits of the dance floor, and the club's history are the focus of the film 24 Hour Party People starring Steve Coogan

After years of neglect, the site



was bought by developers in 2004, who demolished the nightclub and built flats – keeping the iconic moniker which meant clubbers with happy memories of house-music fuelled nights could find a home in their former hangout.

This two-bedroom, eighth floor apartment has stacks of floor-to-ceiling windows with smart lighting throughout, a central music hub with speakers in every room and contemporary bathrooms. It's also got a balcony, secure allocated car parking and 24-hour concierge and is on the market for £349,950

#### Live in a bit of Lennon history


JOHN Lennon's wedding day to first wife Cynthia was far from swinging. The 1962 ceremony at the Mount Pleasant Register office in Liverpool had fellow Beatles McCartney and George Harrison as guests with manager Brian Epstein, best man, but the couple didn't have any flowers or a photographer.

The wedding party celebrated afterwards in Reece's restaurant, which wasn't licensed to serve alcohol, so guests had to toast the couple with water. And the newlyweds didn't even get a honeymoon, as Lennon had to play a gig at the Riverpark Ballroom in Chester that night

Cynthia Lennon, who died last year, met Lennon at Liverpool Art College and while the Beatle was performing in Hamburg, rented his bedroom from his aunt Mimi Smith. They married after she became pregnant, but when Beatlemania took off, she had to deny being his wife. After several affairs, Lennon cheated on her with Yoko, prompting a swift divorce in 1968 when she

# Did Coco go for a cruise on this? EW YORKER

orn in a poorhouse, the 20th century's most famous fashion designer Coco Chanel's life was a true rags to riches tale.

A tough businesswoman with a flair for sewing, she hit the big-time and joined French high society, amassing a \$19bn fortune before her death in 1971, making her one of the richest women of all time. Witty and mesmerizing, Chanel became muse, patron, or mistress to the century's most celebrated artists including Picasso, Dalí, and Stravinsky.

Another of her affairs was with American entrepreneur Harrison Williams, who in 1929 was the richest man in

America, controlling nearly one-sixth of all American utilities. Williams also moved in high circles and was friends with Edward VIII, who stayed at his home during American trips

Williams owned this houseboat, The New Yorker built in 1928 and one of a handful of surviving 'flyers' of about 300 ever made that were used by wealthy businessmen to commute from their seaside mansions to marinas in Manhattan.

The 66ft motor yacht had a spell in service during World War Two when it helped the British government rescue stranded sailors, but went back into private ownership

PH has been a houseboat in recent

#### The real home of James Bond

DANIEL Craig's rumoured to have been offered \$150m to reprise his role as 007 in the next two instalments of the blockbuster spy serial. However, the reluctant star famously remarked that he'd, "rather break this glass and slash my wrists" than utter the words, "Bond, James Bond" onscreen again.

So with a possible vacancy, bookies are taking bets on other Brit stars filling Craig's shoes, including James Norton, Idris Elba, Jamie Bell, Poldark star Aidan Turner, Damian Lewis and Tom Hardy. Even Gillian Anderson's name has cropped up as a possible gender-bending Bond.

While playing the international spy, Daniel Craig escaped to Skyfall Lodge in the 2012 movie, his country ancestral home in the highlands of Scotland, which he hadn't visited since his parent's death.

But in London, Ian

Fleming's Bond books had the hero living in Royal Avenue just off the Kings Road in Chelsea, with an elderly Scottish housekeeper named May. His converted Regency house had a book-lined sitting room with a direct phone line to SIS headquarters in the bedroom

The swanky road was designed by Sir Christopher Wren on behalf of William III in the 1690s as part of a proposed carriageway linking the Royal Hospital to Kensington Palace.





# Jaguar gets back on track

#### BY ENDA MULLEN

Jaguar's return to motor racing after a 12-year absence is as much about testing the electric vehicle technologies that will spur the car maker's continued growth as claiming honours on the racetrack

That was the verdict of Nick Rogers, Jaguar Land Rover's executive director, product engineering, as the Coventry-based car maker officially launched its first all-electric Jaguar Racing car, the I-TYPE 1.

The car will compete in the fastgrowing FIA Formula E series, the third season of which is set to get under way in just a month's time. Jaguar's return to global motor-

port also sees it team-up with electronics giant Panasonic as its official partner. Panasonic Jaguar Racing will

take to the track for the first time in Hong Kong on October 9 with drivers Adam Carroll, Mitch Evans and reserve driver Ho-Pin Tung.

Jaguar Land Rover, now the UK's largest R&D investor, has pledged the Formula E championship will serve as a platform to develop the next generation of electric powered road cars. Speaking at the launch of Panasonic Jaguar Racing, Mr Rogers underlined the important



role Formula E will play in developing electric vehicle technology and the importance of electric vehicles in Jaguar Land Rover's future product portfolio. He said: "Over the next five

years we will see more changes in the automotive world than in the last three decades.

"The championship will enable us to engineer and test our advanced technologies under extreme performance conditions. "We will apply this vital knowledge as part of our real world

development. At Jaguar Land Rover we employ 9,000 engineers and the team will draw on these engineers to extract data and push the boundaries of electric technology in a race environment."

He added: "All of the technology is being pushed to the limits on the racetrack and that technology will flow back into road vehicles.

"I promise you I will soon be telling you about new products that will have this new technology in."

Formula E sees electric racing cars compete on inner city circuits around the world. James Barclay, Panasonic Jaguar Racing team director, said: "We want to be successful on and off the track.

We know that the challenge will be strong - our competitors have a two-year head start. "We will be keeping our

expectations in check in our first season.

"Ultimately we're here to win but we're here to innovate too.

# Renault Kadjar Take a look inside. . .

Renault is careful about the new models it offers British buyers, keeping some firmly to the other side of the English Channel.

So, you can't walk into your local Renault showroom and order a new Talisman or Espace, because the company reckons not enough of us would buy one. Might be right on the

Talisman but the people carrying Espace is such a stunner you'd think it might succeed on looks alone. Which brings us to a Renault you can buy from the dealer down the road and it's a looker as well.

The Kadjar is Renault's larger car entry to the crosso-ver market (with the smaller Captur a rung down the ladder) and comes at a time when we can't get enough of something that looks like a hatchback on steroids.

Something like the Nissan Qashqai, for instance. This massive seller donates big profits to its maker, and lots of parts. . . to the Renault Kadjar. Both are products of the

Renault-Nissan Alliance and beneath both Qashqai and Kadjar you'll find the same engines and body platforms, The bits you can see are

different - and to these eyes

the Kadjar is much the better looking car, inside and out, with a bit of catwalk attitude to its bodywork creases and slashes. Present the Kadjar in the flame red of this car (a  $\pounds625$  option) and you have something that looks worth more than the £18,495 that starts the range off.

Add in the 19-inch alloy wheels that come as standard on the Signature Nav grade test car and you have a car that stands out. Inside, there's plenty of room front and rear and a generous

boot. The same crossover genes make the Kadjar look a likely candidate for all-wheel drive, but hardly any of them are and most owners will find their front-wheel drivers can cope with anything an English winter throws at them.

The Signature Nav grade brings - you've guessed - a satellite navigation system. It was easy to use and the route showed up clearly on a nicely sized screen. Also part of the spec is a Bose sound system that pumped out volume but whose alloy coloured logo on the dash top reflected annoyingly in the windscreen.

Niggles aside though, here is a handsome addition to the crossover market that deserves to do well.
