

Received evidence 4/11/68 from SA John F. Gallagher -
Q64, Q4, Q5, Q6, Q7, & Q8.

The jacketed, open-nosed bullets had
all been pulled from their casings (Q4, 5, 6, 7, & 8).

All casings marked "R-P 30-06 SPRG".

A portion of lead from the mutilated
surfaces of Q64 was cut, from which three
samples were cleaned and prepared.

Bullets Q4, Q5, Q6, Q7, & Q8 were
cut approx. in half (\pm to their length),
and three samples were cut from the base half.
One sample was taken from the center of
the bullet at the cut, and two others
were taken from near the edges of the
bullet, diametrically opposite each other.
These samples were then cleaned & prepared.

All samples & stds. cut into cubes.

Evid. returned to Gallagher 4/22/68.
