**HUAC Will Ask  
Citations for 3**

The House will be asked after Labor Day to cite three Chicago persons for contempt for refusal to answer questions before the House Committee on Un-American Activities, Chairman Edwin E. Willis (D-La.) told newsmen yesterday.

He had said previously that contempt citations would be sought but declined to say when.

The three, Dr. Jeremiah Stanler, Mrs. Yolenda Hall and Milton Cohen, were recommended for citations last January at the same time that the Committee took similar action against seven leaders of the Ku Klux Klan. All three refused to answer questions in May 1965 during a hearing on activities of the Communist Party in Illinois.
