Pair Arrested In Slaying of Cycle Club Chief

WEST HOLLYWOOD, Calif., June 3 (UPI)—Two men were in custody today on suspicion of fatally shooting the president of a motorcycle club called the Death Riders in front of a Sunset Boulevard bar.

Sheriff's deputies said Jack De Vane, 23, of Hollywood, was killed by a single blast from a 12-gauge shotgun as he emerged from the Melody Room bar early Monday.

Arrested after a brief automobile chase were Henry House 38, of Hollywood and Eugene Duncan, 23. Both were booked on suspicion of murder.

No motive for the slaying was disclosed. However, deputies said De Vane had been involved in an argument with the suspects in a Los Angeles market a short time before he was shot.
