Pagan's Body Found in Steel Drum

investigating the death of a 22-year-old member of the Pagans Motorcycle Club whose body was found Sunday welded inside a steel barrel in the Chesapeake and Delaware Canal.

The man was identified as Joseph K. Vargas, of Woodbridge, Va., who was reported missing to State police on July 6, after he disappeared from three-day encampment of about 300 Pagans near North East, Md., on July 3, 4 and 5.

An Oxford, Pa., man who was fishing at low tide along the canal near Chesapeake City spotted the barrel about 5 p.m. Sunday. Police believe the barrel was washed up on the sandy shore of the swiftly flowing canal during high tide.

According to 1st Sgt. Robert C. Adams of the Cecil County Sheriff's Department, the top had been spot-welded onto the drum and steel bands had been welded up the sides and across the top.
