AMONG ITEMS RECOVERED FROM ROOM PREVIOUSLY OCCUPIED BY HIM AT FOUR SIX TWO DUNDAS STREET WEST, TORONTO, UP UNTIL MAY NINE LAST, WERE FIVE ROLLS OF KODAK SUPER EIGHT CARRIDGE TYPE COLOR MOVIE FILM, LOT NO. K A FOUR SIX FOUR, EXPIRATION DATE NOVEMBER NINETEEN SIXTY EIGHT. EIGHTEEN OUNCE JAR COLD CREAM, NUMEROUS MISCELLANEOUS BANDAIDS AND THREE BROWN PAPERSACKS, A GRAY METAL STRONGBOX, AND A DARK BLUE ZIPPER TYPE FLIGHT BAG. ALL ABOVE FIRMS PROCESSED BY RCMP, TORONTO, ONTARIO, BUT ONLY ONE FINGERPRINT OF QUESTIONABLE VALUE DEVELOPED.

ONLY ONE OF THE PACKS OF FILM APPEARED TO HAVE BEEN OPENED BUT NOT KNOWN WHETHER CONTAINS ANY EXPOSURES. THIS BEING PROCESSED BY KODAK AT TORONTO.

ONTARIO, WHO HANDLED FLIGHT BOOKING AND OBTAINING OF PASSPORT FOR SUBJECT, INTERVIEWED IN DETAIL TODAY. INVESTIGATION AT TORONTO ESTABLISHED THAT IN ADDITION TO CANADIAN PASSPORT IN NAME RAMON GEORGE SNEYD, SUBJECT ALSO HAS BIRTH CERTIFICATE IN THAT NAME WHICH HE OBTAINED FROM BUREAU OF VITAL STATISTICS, TORONTO, BY LETTER DATED APRIL SIXTEEN LAST. CERTIFICATE ATTESTING TO HIS BIRTH AT TORONTO ON OCTOBER EIGHT, MINETEEN THIRTY TWO, BEARS THE NAMES OF PARENTS AS FATHER GEORGE SNEYD AND MOTHER MAIDEN NAME GLADYS MAE KILNER (THESE ARE THE CORRECT NAMES OF THE PARENTS OF THE REAL RAMON GEORGE SNEYD).
