Enclosed for the Bureau are the original and one copy of an anonymous postcard directed to Mr. E. RAY, Memphis, Tennessee, which was postmarked New York, New York, P.M., 7/22/68.

Enclosed for New York is one Xerox copy of the original postcard described above.

For the information of the Bureau and New York, the enclosed postcard which is self-explanatory was turned over to SA ROBERT F. BOYLE on 7/24/68 by [redacted] Intelligence Squad, Memphis PD, who is currently assigned in charge of the security of subject RAY during RAY's confinement at the Shelby County Jail, Memphis.

The contents of the message contained on the enclosed postcard that was directed to Mr. E. RAY was discussed with USA THOMAS L. ROBINSON, Memphis, by [redacted] on 7/24/68. Mr. ROBINSON stated that the contents of this communication does imply a threat on the life of RAY, therefore, he would consider
