Transmitted herewith are two Xerox copies of a registration card located on April 11, 1969, at the Birmingham Travelodge Motel, 821 South 20th Street in the Five Points South area of Birmingham recording the registration of ERIC S. GALT, 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama, on 3/29/68 who is undoubtedly identical with RAY. Registration card reflects he was assigned Room 307, one in party, and charged for one day, departing at an unspecified time on 3/30/68. He was in possession of a 1966 Mustang with Alabama license 138993 which has previously been identified as having been registered by RAY at Birmingham on 10/2/67 under the alias ERIC S. GALT with the same residence address indicated. Since guest registrations are maintained in a very haphazard manner at the Travelodge Motel, it was difficult to locate this card since an entire package of guest registrations with the numerical series 18500 could not be located in a storeroom box where other registration cards for the year 1968 were examined.
