■ **James Earl Ray**, convicted of murdering **Martin Luther King Jr.**, was released from a Nashville hospital yesterday. Ray, 68, had lapsed into a coma last week. His condition improved, and he has been transferred to a prison hospital. Ray is serving a 99-year sentence for the 1968 shooting death of the civil rights leader.
