



Dear Mr. Hoover,

The situation looks SO hopeless down here in Texas! The country seems to be heading down the road to subjugation. I feel sorry for you, because I sincerely feel that you are one of the few remaining patriots left in Washington.

Doesn't the situation become almost overwhelming at times? Especially with the Supreme Court rulings frustating you at every turn?

When the recent presidential election was in full swing, I went around town with the sticker: Goldwater-Hoover on my car. The only thing, you boys weren't nominated! (I trust you like Mr. Goldwater as well as I do.)

My purpose in writing this letter is not only to thank you for your worthwhile work as a patriot in trying to preserve this republic from those who have sworn to bury us, but also to ask you if there isn't comething more I as a private citizen can do to help my country.

At the present time, I try to keep informed on legislation in Congress, who voted for what, etc.; write congressmen; talk Americanism with my patients; try to point out the urgency of the Communist menace, and the necessity for recognizing that menace; encourage hard work, and good citizenship; try to be independent, and teach my patients to think independently of the Federal Government; encouraging the Free Enterprise System; and, lastly, flying the U.S. flag whenever possible. He was advised that an unnamed individual from Columbus. Ohio who had attended an Evangelistic meeting at the Ohio, had contacted the Columbus RA. marvial had advised that Rev. had made the statement "Registered Communists are connected with our National Council of Churches" and that proof could be obtained from the TBI in Washington, D.C.

denied having made quoted statement concerning registered communists. He felt that he had probably made a statement to the effect that communists have nfilipated the National Federal Council of Churches. Rev. and been under the impression the FBI in Washington would furnish material to citizens concerning communism although he knew the FBI would not be able to furnish publications documenting individuals as "registered communists".

Rev. was advised that the FBI does not comment concerning the character or integrity of any organization, publication or individual. He was advised that the FBI has made no comment concerning the National Council of Churches or any similar organization.

Rev. was requested that in the future, remarks to his audiences should be made clear that the FBI has made no comment concerning the National Federal Council of Churches and further that the FBI will not furnish to anyone other than duly-authorized agencies of the Federal Government, information from its confidential files.

Rev. was furnished a copy of the manuscript of Chief Inspector WILLIAM C. SULLIVAN entitled "Communism and Religion" dated 2/22/61. In reviewing Page 5 of this manuscript, Rev. seized upon the word "substantial" in the statement "...the Communist Party, USA, has not achieved any substantial success in exerting domination, control or influence over America's clergymen or religious institutions on a national scale." He attempted to get SA to comment that by inference this must mean that there has been some communist infiltration of the National Federal Council of Churches. SA of course, had absolutely no comment on this matter.

Rev. expressed high admiration for the work of the FPI. He is using Director HOOVER's books and public statements as source material for his sermons on the dangers of communium. He has served as a missionary in during the and as such has had first-hand experience with refugees from communium. He does not have a copy of Mr. HOOVER's "Masters of Deceit" and it was suggested to him that he might desire to purchase a copy for use in his pastoral work.

Rev. was concerned that others who had participated in his Evangelistic meetings at might have also gained the wrong impression from his remarks. He contemplates sending a letter to Rev.

Pastor of the reading at a worship service so as to explain that he (kev. had not meant to give the impression that "Registered communists are connected with the National Federal Council of Churches." In this letter, he would also correct the impression which he had left with his audience that the FBI would furnish documentary proof of this fact to those who might request same from the FBI.

As a result of the conversation with Rev. it appeared to SA that the authoritative statements contained

in Chief Inspector SULLIVAN's manuscript had no effect whatsoever in changing Rev. conviction that the National Federal Council of Churches in thoroughly infiltrated by the communists. Rev. indicated that his religious convictions place him with the Tundamentalists" in Protestant religious theology and he feels that the National Federal Council of Churches is inclined toward "modernity". Further, his convictions that the National Federal Council of Churches and the Protestant clergy (other than, of course, the pastors belonging to the fundamentalist sects) are thoroughly infiltrated by communists give him one of his bettertalling points in his Evangelistic sermons.

Rev. was not antagonistic. As mentioned above, he expressed great admiration for the work of the FBI. He indicated regret that his lack of knowledge concerning the furtions of the FBI had made it necessary for an Agent to take time from his other important assignments to contact him. He requested that any available material concerning communism and crime be sent to him.

Indianapolis recommends that the Bureau packets on both crime and communism be sent to Rev.



Dr. Fred S Buschmeyer, the Washington secretary of the NCCC, telephone LI 4-2350, called Mr. Kemper on 5-8-61 stating captioned individual would like to arrange an appointment with the Director at Mr. Hoover's convenience. According to Dr. Buschmeyer, Miller is very wealthy and travels constantly throughout the country. If the Director should indicate he can see Miller, he (Miller) will fly to Washington for the appointment. Dr. Buschmeyer requested to be called regarding the result of Miller's request.

INFORMATION IN BUREAU FILES:

The current edition of "Who's Who" lists James Irwin Miller as a manufacturer in Columbus, Indiana. He was born on 5-26-09, and received an A. B. degree from Yale University in 1931, an M. A. degree from Oxford (England) University in 1933, and an LL.D. degree from Bethany College in 1956.

Based on available information, the only reference identifiable in Bureau files regarding Miller was a United Press International ticker, dated 6-26-59, which reported that Senator Homer E. Capehart had asked President Eisenhower to appoint J. Erwin Miller, wealthy Columbus, Indiana, industrialist, as the Secretary of Commerce. (62-46126-A)

The National Council of Churches of Christ (NCCC) includes in its membership the leading Protestant churches in the country. Various critics of the Council, without access to factual data to support their assertions, have claimed this group is communist controlled or influenced. Although the Bureau has not investigated the NCCC, we have kept abreast of the efforts of the Communist Party, USA (CPUSA) to infiltrate it through our over-all investigation of the Party and communist efforts to infiltrate mass-type organizations. From information developed, it does not appear that the policies of the NCCC are being dictated by the Communist REC 23 Party.







Rev. Blake blasted Robert Welsh and the John Birch Society so much that we would also like any information available on it.



SYNOPSIS

Vestry Committee of St. Mark's Episcopal Church, Shreveport, Louisiana, has prepared well-documented report concerning National Council of the Churches of Christ in the USA (NCCCA). This is very critical of NCCCA and contains a resolution by the Church Vestry that the Protestant Episcopal Church should withdraw from the NCCCA.

Vestry Committee's report criticizes NCCCA for speaking out, as the official voice of Protestantism in America, on controversial issues such as the seating of Red China in the United Nations. It states that NCCCA, "although not communistic, has been an aid to the communist conspiracy." (underlining added) An ong NCCCA pronouncements and activities which the report berates is a pamphlet entitled "The Negro American--A Reading List" published by the Department of Racial and Cultural Relations of the NCCCA which lists books by W. E. B. DuBois, Herbert Aptheker and others of their ilk.

Vestry Committee's report contains references to FBI and Director indicating Committee holds Bureau in high esteem. Among specific items cited by Vestry Committee to substantiate its opposition to NCCCA are remarks last December by Dr. Joseph B. Hunter of Little Rock, who is affiliated with NCCCA, that "the FBI is just a secret police network which infringes on the individual rights of man."

Copy of Vestry Committee's report and copy of transcript of conference between Committee and Dr. J. Quinter Miller of NCCCA are attached.

DETAILS

In an envelope postmarked May 29, 1961, and bearing the return address of St. Mark's Episcopal Church, Shreveport, Louisiana, the Bureau has received copies of a booklet concerning the National Council of the Churches of Christ in the USA (NCCCA). This booklet, which is most critical of the NCCCA, consists of a well-documented report concerning the NCCCA by a Vestry Committee of St. Mark's Church.

Review of this booklet reveals, that the Vestry Committee obviously devoted a great deal of time, energy and funds to its study of the NCCCA. Based upon the Committee's findings, the Vestry of St. Mark's Episcopal Church adopted a resolution on April 21, 1961, that "the Bishop of Louisiana be and he is hereby petitioned immediately to take such steps as may be necessary and expedient to cause the Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America to withdraw from The National Council of the Churches of Christ in the United States."

HIGH LIGHTS OF THE VESTRY COMMITTEE'S FINDINGS

(1) On page 1, the report (copy attached) states, "The NCCCA has done and is doing a great number of things that we feel are not in the best interest of the Church. We have proved beyond a reasonable doubt that it has made a practice of speaking on behalf of all members of the 34 denominations comprising the NCCCA, when it is in fact not specifically authorized to do so. In this regard, it has been deceitful, in that it actually did desire the impression to be made on the public that it spoke officially for 'the 39 million ' (39 million members of the 34 denominations comprising the NCCCA).

"The NCCCA has far exceeded its rightful role in speaking out, as the official voice of Protestantism in America, on such controversial issues as federal aid to education, the right-to-work laws, the ethical considerations of the steel dispute, the seating of Red China in the United Nations, etc.

"The NCCCA, although not communistic, has been an aid to the communist conspiracy." (underlining added)



(2) On page 2, the Vestry Committee sums up its findings with the conclusion that "the National Council of Churches as it is presently constituted and operated, is a harmful and highly dangerous institution."

ISSUE OF COMMUNISM

On pages 10 and 11, the Vestry Committee reports that it could find no instance where "any responsible person" has accused the NCCCA of being a communist front or of having communists in executive or administrative posts—"But there is room for discussion of the extent to which activities or Pronouncements of the NCCCA or of high officials within it may have paralleled propaganda of the communists."

The report is particularly critical of Dr. Edwin T. Dahlberg, immediate past president of the NCCCA, "who has been attacked most strongly as furthering causes which the Communists wish furthered."

In criticising the NCCCA's position regarding Red China, the report states, "When the National Council's World Order Study Conference in Cleveland in 1955 recommended recognition of Red China by the United States and inclusion of it in the United Nations, the Committee of One Million Against the Admission of Communist China to the United Nations conducted a poll of Protestant clergymen throughout the nation... More than 8,000 Protestant clerygmen responded to this poll by mail. Of this total, 87 per cent opposed both admission of Red China to United Nations and recognition by the United States. Only 11 per cent were in favor. Two per cent favored recognition but opposed admission, or vice versa, or said they could not make up their minds."

The Vestry Committee also cites the anti-HCUA attitude openly displayed by members of the NCCCA; and it deals very critically with a pamphlet entitled "The Negro American--A Reading List" published by the Department of Racial and Cultural Relations of the NCCCA which lists books by W. E. B. DuBois, Herbert Aptheker and others of that ilk.

SEVERAL REFERENCES TO FBI AND DIRECTOR

Throughout the booklet, there are several references to the FBI and the Director which disclose that the Vestry Committee holds the Bureau in high esteem. In addition, "Masters of Deceit" is favorably quoted.

As part of the material to substantiate its opposition to the NCCCA, the Vestry Committee has cited a newspaper article published last December in which Dr. Joseph B. Hunter of Little Rock (who is affiliated with the NCCCA) was quoted saying, "I think the FBI and the House Committee on Un-American Activities got together and subpoenaed a group of persons, hired a film company and then went out to San Francisco to make a propaganda movie ("Operation Abolition") in an effort to help the HCUA get their financial appropriations next month from Congress.... After all, the FBI is just a secret police network which infringes on the individual rights of man."

You requested a memorandum showing the actions sponsored by the National Council of Churches of Christ (NCCC) that follow the Communist Party (CP) line. Set forth below are actions of the NJCC which parallel the CP line, although it cannot be inferred that the NCCC is following the CP line.

> The Mushington City News Service on 2-25-54 reported that the NCCC had asked The House of Representatives of the United States Congress to curb abuses by the louse Committee on Un-American Activities (.XUA). They reportedly urged that the Committee be halted from spreading malicious gossip through the release of unevaluated accusations from its files about individuals and groups, stating that the information was not checked for accuracy and some of it was false. (100-40552)-4)

The reports of the Fund for the Republic dated 5-01-55 stated that the sums of 510,000 and ου,000, respectively, had been awarded to the Department of Racial and Cultural Relations of the NCCC, which money was to be used for a study of racial discrimination. (106-50869, summary dated 9-9-55)

The 1-1-59 issue of the American Legion "Firing Line" reported that delegates to the World order Study Conference, sponsored by the NCCC, had ununimously urged recognition of Communist China and that Communist China or admitted to the United Nations. Other statements adopted by the Conference called for "stronger efforts should be made to break through the present stalemate and to find ways of living with the communist nations."



Straight Talk

T a recent Presbyterian assembly, the conference elected as head of its theological seminary in SanFrancisco a minister who has proclaimed his disbelief in the Virgin Birth of Christ. The meeting discussed such subjects as sex, birth control, NAACP, federal aid to education. abolishment of capital punishment, federal housing, admission of Communist China to the U.N.—in fact, practically every-

thing except religion.

One of the most outstanding preacher-orators in America Nels F. S. Ferre, wrote this in his book The Christian Understanding of God: "Strange, however, is the hold which this doctrine (the Virgin Birth) . . . has on countless peoples. Reference to the Virgin Birth is not found in Paul's letters, the earliest writings we have. It is not found in Mark, the original Gospel . . . As a matter of fact, the reference in John to the claim by the Jews to the effect that they were not born in adultery, could give external credence to a --Nazi claim that Jesus was German. Mary, we remember, was found pregnant before her engagement to mild Joseph. Nazareth was held by a Roman garrison where the soldiers were German mercenaries. Jesus is also reported throughout a continuous part of the history of art, it is claimed, to have been blond. This is supposedly unnatural for the Mediterranian countries where this same tradition started and was continued. Hence Jesus must have been the ghild of a German soldier."

Of Jesus, Ferre says: "He is at best a vague figure. He never was nor became God." Of Communism, Ferre says: "We shall witness to the Communists because whatever truth is theirs we accept wholeheartedly, and beyond their truth lies God's truth... If Marxism should conquer the whole world, this might be merely the prelude in economic arrangement to the blossoming forth within it of the deeply sowed seed of the Christian faith and expectations."

Some dishelievers and won't-believers cry that such quotes were "taken out of context!" How could the rest of the

book possibly compensate for the above?

National Council of Judases

A proposed amendment to our Constitution reads: "This nation devoutly recognizes the authority and law of Jesus Christ, Savior and Ruler of Nations, through whom are bestowed the blessings of Almighty God." Guess what organization voted 59 to 1 in its General Board meeting against this proposed amendment to reaffirm our nation's belief in Christianity? The National Council of Churches. Reason? The National Council Board stated that such an amendment would "embarrass the relations of American churches and the nation with the world majority of non-Christians." We've spent billions on end for years on end, trying to convert the heathens throughout the world to Christianity—which we don't acknowledge ourselves if it might embarrass "the majority of non-Christians." Wonder what the heathens we converted think of that?

The American Association for Advancement of Atheism in a recent annual report stated: "They are saving the ship of Christianity by throwing her cargo overboard. With what zeal the Fosdicks and Shaler Mathewses and the whole crew or rescuers toss out the Virgin Birth, atonement and the resurrection. We welcome the aid of the Modernists and

pledge them our fullest cooperation in ridding the world of any serious acceptance of Christian theology."

These "Modernists" would replace "The Fatherhood of God" with the "Brotherhood of man." These rewriters of the Bible omitted Acts 8:37 which says, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God." Their "Interpreter's Bible" constantly uses the words "myth," "folklore," "legendary," "fallacy," to describe Christ's miracles. These same characters preside at the serving of Communion, hypocritically serving the body and the blood of the "illegitimate, non-divine offspring of a German soldier and a married woman" to believers on their knees in atonement. We do not have to he theologians to know that if Jesus was not divine. He was not perfect, and vice versa. What is Christianity, if Christ is not divine? These usurpers were not satisfied to start a new roligion. You need to get crucified and rise from the dead to do that. They were determined to infiltrate, destroy and "modernize" ours.

They Know Not What They Do

J. B. Matthews says in his book Communism in the Churches, page 9: "The largest single group supporting the Communist apparatus in the United States today is composed of Protestant clergymen." The House Un-American Activities Committee [which is now fighting for its life] showed as of 1953 that 8,673 American clergymen were in the Communist conspiracy, knowingly or unknowingly. At that time there were 353 Rabbis, 626 Presbyterians, 1,429 Protestant-Episcopal and 2,131 Methodists, among others

These false prophets want to establish peace and world brotherhood by turning convicted Communists out of juil (if they haven't already been released by Supreme Coura decisions); by abolishing investigating committees of the Congress; by killing loyalty oaths; repealing immigration and security laws; forgetting the enslaved Hungarians. Poles. Chinese, Ukrainians, etc. and ending—not winning—the Cold War; and cutting defense efforts.

The preacher in his pulpit holds a special niche—a link between communicants and God. He is their spiritual mentor, giving his life to God in the highest calling to which man can be called. He has baptised, christened, comforted, married, blessed, advised, guided, inspired and buried us and our beloved. We believe and believe in our minister. So when he is led into integrating the spiritual with the economic and preaching a collectivist New World Order to us, we are caught off guard.

A preacher (as well as a "professional Christian" on a church payroll) should be even more responsible for what he says and signs and joins than other people. If he cooperates with or joins individuals or groups dedicated to the violent overthrow of our country, then he should pay the consequences.

Some of the leaders of the NCC cried "foul" when "Christian Crusade," "Circuit Riders" and other Christian patriotic organizations published the facts which were re-published recently in the Air Force Training Manual. Most preachers are intelligent, wonderful men, dedicated to God and country. But some preachers are emotional, naive and ill-informed on worldly affairs. You might expect these errant preachers, instead of crying "foul," to step forward in public repentance and say: "Forgive me Lord, for I know not what I did!"

Our community has been hit by a barrage of literature condemning the "National Council of Churches in Christ, America" as Communistic. The Revised Standard Version of the Bible as being done by thirty Communists, that about one third of the Protestant Einisters are communistic, come ing U.S. participation in the United Nations, Society of Friends (Quakers) and other such charges as these.

One group, "United Christian Study Group" of Hannibal, Mo. showed a filmstrip "Communism On The Map" by George S. Benson of the National Education Program which has upset many of us because it infers that Presidents, Rocsevelt, Truman, Eisenhower, V.P. Nixon, Sec. of State Herter, Milton Eisenhower, John Foster Dulles, Allan Dulles and others are associated with the Communist conspiracy in America.

De: r Mr. Hoover:

The enclosed article from the April 30th Columbus (Ohio) Dispetch reises a question which I wish to ask you.

I believe that loyal Americans and Protestents who are disturbed by the present situation in churches, do not think that, (quoting Mr. Cassels), "a substantial number of Christian elergymen are secret supporters of the Communist conspiracy," or that "churches are overrun with Reds." However, we do believe that many elergymen have been misinformed about some important truths, and hence are dupes of the Communists.

When the National Council of Churches, (claiming to represent 39,000,000 of us), discredits the film "Operation Abolition," and when clergymen speck against this film and even commend and support those who cause disturbances at the showing of the film, I find it difficult to be silent. What should we do?

Would Mr. Sullivan's speeches (referred to and quoted in Mr. Cassels' article), answer my question? If so, are copies available? If Mr. Sullivan has spoken in this area, I have not seen notice of it.

There must be some course other than complete silence for "amateur Communist hunters" who want to do the right thing. 




