

Buy remarks by a representative of this Bureau, however, should not be interpreted as a defense or endorsement of any group, since this is not a proper function of the FBL

Our churches have been and will continue to be important targets in the over-all communist program of endeavoring to infiltrate our established institutions, and we must remain alert to such efforts to subvert our way of life. Eithe communists have tried to infiltrate every part of our society, and I agree with you wholeheartedly that patriotic Americans must continue to take a firm stand against communism and combat it wherever possible. But this opposition o communism must be careful, constructive and positive; and it must always e kept within the due process of law. In reference to Mr. Castels' article, Assistant Director William C. Sullivan, in his discussion of communism dealt with this subject accurately and objectively.

Dear Mr. Hoover,

First, I shall have to confess that I have est one of tal....

terrible "right-wing conservatives" for as long as I can remember. In my
high school class I stood completely alone in my belief that the OPA
should be allowed to die----and that was 16 years ag: I clong to none
of the organizations formed to discuss or actively fight collectivism,
Communism, and such; although for several years I have been reading and
studying the threat of Communism and trying to influence whomever I can
to do likewise. I have believed that I cannot swaken anyone to the dangers
facing us as a nation unless they will "do their homework"; then they will
make these discoveries for themselves.

I am a mother of four youngsters aged five to nine, a Methodist who attends church with her children and husband every Sunday. I was elected permanent class secretery at Indiana University from which I was graduated with "high distintion".

All of this background is only to belp you see (I bope) that I am a very normal person who tries bard to do right and has enough intelligence to discern right from wrong. I have read many books and papers of both the conservative and liberal persuasion and feel that I am as objective as possible in my criticism of those who do not agree with me.

My immediate problem is my forthcoming participation in a panel discussion for our church on the National Council of Churches of Christ in America. In my criticism of the Mational Council of Churches I intend to avoid any charges of Communist influence within the church or the Council because I honestly feel there are enough other valid arguments to use. I know, however, that in the question period to follow, these charges will be broght up. My minister, who wholeheartedly supports the Council, will see that they are aired, feeling that we have no believable evidence. I have tried to make him understand why I feel that although "a Christian minister couldn't be a Communist", a Communist could become a Christian minister. But more important to me --- that whether a minister is an actual Communist or not isn't the most important thing. If the clergy supports their program time and again, they are of infinite more worth than a party member would be. The leading churchmen of our city, the most vocal raid the most prominent, have the most externe left-wing views --- which views they preach as the only Christian views. These men, and my minister is among them, diffifs any charge of subversion as a personal insult and ridiculous. They use the quoted statements of Mr. William C. Sullives from the article of Louis Cassels which I have enclosed. This article appeared in our local paper Reveral months ago. I worried about these starements at



Your local agents were most cooperative and understanding and completely uncommunicative --- as I am sure they are supposed to be. We decided after his visit that since we knew Louis Cassels, the UPI writer, to be quite also liberal and an applogist for the National Council, that perhaps be had quoted out of context or had allowed his bias to unduly emphasize what he wanted emphasized. future of their country?

Our Consittee (Consittee of Christian Laymen) was organized for the purpose of bringing about a change in policies of the Mational Council of Churches of Christ, Our group is opposed to the idea of the Mational Council making pronouncements on pelitical and economic matters in the mase of 39,000,000 Pretestants. Enclosed are copies of two full page advertisements which set out our views.

In doing our research we have come across some things which to us are quite disturbing: 2 NA 17 8/201 2

- 1. R. W. Roon (active in the M.C.C.) and a Methodist minister at Fresno, made a speech before the Fifth Assembly of M.C.C. (Dec. 4, 1960) condemning the film, "Operation Abolition", and contending it was all a lie.
- 2. Christian Century Magazine, issue of Jan. 4, 1961, had an article, "Operation Abolition" by R. W. Moon, repeating what he said before the N.C.C. assembly. In the same issue was an editorial, "Abolish H.V.A.C."
- 5. The article by R. W. Hoon and the editorial were reprinted on one page (front and back) by Christian Century. The Chicago Committee to Defend the Bill of Rights, Suite \$11. 189 West Madison St., Chicago 2, Illinois, apparently paid for and distributed these reprints through churches and other avenues. We have a copy in our possession.
- 4. A letter dated January 24, 1961, on the letterhead of Chicago Committee to Defend the Bill of Rights, indicates that it is a new organization whose primary purpose is to abolish the Mouse Va-American Activities Committee. We have a photostat of this letter in our possession.

5. Richard L. Oriley and Leon Entzen, both previously identified as Communists by your Committee, are listed on the letterhead of Chicago Committee to Defend the Bill of Rights.

- 6. We have in our possession the Christian Century reprints, furnished by Chicago Committee to Defend the Bill of Rights and carrying their imprints, which in turn were mailed out by local churches to their members.
- 7. Did Christian Century knowingly enter into an arrangement with Chicago Committee to Defend the Bill of Rights whereby this Committee was the principal purchaser of these reprints, which it then in turn furnished free to local churches for redistribution?
- 8. We note that Christian Century is owned by the Christian Century Foundation, among whose trustees are some of the Key people of the Mational Council of Churches (March 1, 1961 issue of Christian Century).
- 9. Almost every issue of Christian Century Suring the Calendar Year 1961 has articles or items in regard to "Operation Abolition" or the necessity for getting rid of the House Vn-American Activities Committee, including suggestions for opposing the showing of the film or heckling where shown.
- 10. The Christian Century, reflecting Entional Council of Churches attitude, is either for or against F.B.I. director J. Edgar Heover, depending upon how it best serves their purpose.
  - (a) Christian Century, issue of April 5, 1961, page 414, wy.B.I. Inspector Defends Protestant Clergy" uses this sarcasm: "Although we are happy to learn that the Pederal Bureau of Investigation is capable of such insight, we felt no compulsion to rush this statement into print."
  - (b) Tet Eugene Carson Blake in literature distributed by local churches quotes freely from F.B.I. Cnief Inspector William G. Sullivan to indicate that attacks upon the Metional Council of Churches are not justified. Many people reading this material assume that Mr. Sullivan has been sent out by Mr. J. Edgar Moover to defend the Metional Council of Churches. Our Committee has had this with which to contend.


The more research that our Committee has done, the more we become convinced that the Matienal Council of Churches has its own axe to grind in opposing, with every means at its command, the House Un-American Activities Committee and to a somewhat leaser degree the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Dear Mr. Hoover:

Re: Number of ministers unwittingly aiding the Communist movement

I surely do not understand the FBI assistant making the statement at Dallas, Texas, Thursday to the effect that the proportion who unwittingly help the Communist movement is exceedingly small.—see clipping.

How can he say that, when the National Council of Churches is battling us on every side, and is following so closely many of the points in the Communist line? The ministers in the National Council have much influence, I think, and other ministers would try to carry out as many of their recommendations as nossible, unless they had already been made aware of the problem. Our experience here is that it must be the unusual minister who will stand against the National Council, and who will study this material along with the Anti-Communists. I give a few examples: (as basis for these opinions)

1. The St. Marks Vestry Committee report of the National Council of Churches, St. Mark's EPiscopal Church, Shrevenort, Louisiana. On page 2 is the sentence: "In summation, we conclude with firm conviction and only after long study and prayer, that the National Council of Churches as it is presently constituted?" and operated, is a harmful and highly dangerous institution."

2. Articles written by clergy who wittingly or unwittingly are eiding the Communist movement go out to the ministers and lay people in every state of this nation, and elsewhere, I suppose. On page 3 of a little Methodist pamphlet called "Concern", is an article by The Reverend Robert W. Moon, pastor of the First Methodist church, Fresno, California, chairman of the Policy and Statement committee of the Division of Peace and World Order The title of the article is: "Operation Abolition" -- an honest film?"and the first sentence says: "A dangerous piece of propaganda is being distributed throughout the country in the form of a movie called 'Operation Abolition." At the bottom of the same page is the sentence: "It is not an honest movie." And on page 4 is the section of the article entitled "What can you do", with the following suggestion: "2) If you hear that an organization is planning to show the movie, go to the leader and tell him the facts, trying to persuade him not to show the film." I was sent this magazine by the chairman of the Spokane District of the Woman's Society of Christian Service. Her letter, along the same line, I am enclosing. (Please return.) I suppose most of the other district chairmen on the same returnly women's sent out similar letters to women throughout the United

I quote from The Congregational Way, issue for May, 1961, which gives a report of the work of Dr. Julien J. Keiser at the five Christian Social Action Workshops held in the Washington Conference in March of 1961: "Dr. Keiser gave special attention at each of the Workshops to the threat of Communism, and the Church's responsibility. 'Such well organized groups as the John Birch Society, Pro-America, the Freedom Clubs...the House Un-American Activities Committee and other "super-patriotic" groups tends to exaggerate the threat of internal Communism to the American Way of life, said Dr. Keiser."

4. The minister of the Kellogg church I still attend told me this summer, in reference to "Operation Abolition": "How can you believe it is good? It is complete fabrication."

5. We see our Sanday School material, as sponsored by our church authorities (I presume ministers are included in this group), getting farther and farther away from actual Bible study. This is a whole subject in itself--but I will give one example. For 3 months last year my 3rd grade son and my 4th grade granddaughter (in separate classes, about 20 or 25 children total) studied the Lord's Prayer at about the rate of one line per Sunday; and the following 3 months studied the following persons at about the rate of 2 Sundays for each person listed: St. Francis of Assisi; Michael Punin; George Washington Carver; Helen Keller; Marie Curie; and Jane Adams. All good neonle and good material, yes. But the noint is that for 6 months these children had very few actual Bible stories. This is from the Group Graded Pilgrim Press material of the Congregational Church, and is being revised, I believe. But we aren't harpy with the revised booke either. They seem to have less Bible stories than this. The cuarter: containing this material is/called "Wonders of God", end was used during Arril, Lav and June. The quarterly called "The Lord's Prayer" preceded "Wonders of God", and was used during January. February and March.

For the above reasons and more, I feel I must disagree with Mr. Sullivan's position as stated in the paper, at least. I think the number of ministers, and thereby the proportion of ministers who at least "unwittingly aided the Communist movement" must be much larger than the phrase "exceedingly small" would indicate. Would you have time to give us your eminion of this matter?

This is power, intelligence, fove, compassion, truth and life. We cannot direct ourselves when consumed by hysteria, fear and reactionary opinion. In the case of the 92 professors of the University of Mashington signing a petition to prohibit the showing of the film, COMMUNICAL DN THE MAP, criticism of their actions points out that academic freedom may again be in jespardy as it was in the era of McCarthyism.

If you are unable to present this to your society, I will be willing to do so. Wo must unheld the principals of the Methodist Church and its SOCIAL CREED.

In all the areas there are to think about, there is surely some phase of C.S.R. that each society may have one meeting, even one buzz session about. Your work in the District brings a rich reward; the effort you give is a timeless gift, and you may have the knowledge that your efforts, added to all the others in like work are doing many things to help people everywhere to live better, fuller lives.

Dear Mr. Hoover:

I am sure you have received a great deal of mail, pro and con, concerning the recently-mushrooming distortionist cults speaking out against many loyal American citizens under the label of patrioties. Personally I believe such groups (e.g., the Houstoneers, the John Birchers, etc.) not only help Communism but hinder the work of those fighting the influence of Communism with more same, rational methods.

For this reason, I expressed concern to the manager of our local radion station over the broadcast of a program KNOW THINE ENEMY on public service time. I feel that, if it-is broadcast at all-and that I'm not too sure of-it should be done under private spon sorship, and not given public service time. Not only is the announcer on KNOW THINK ENEMY one of these glip sort of people who sounds to my ears as if he has very little sincersty; I have even heard him mispronounce several fairly common words on his program. Further, I am appalled at the highly distorted manner in which KNOW THINE ENDAY has attacked the President, the Mational Council of Churches, and a number of other promiment individuals and groups.





For some time I have greatly admired your various writings on the general subject of communism. It was not until you recently replied to an inquiry written by a friend of mine that I realized you would take the time from your busy schedule to answer questions.

During the past few months a number of members of our congregation (Protestant Episcopal) have been trying to alert our priest and vestry to the threat to our freedom posed by communism. The subject of infiltration of the Episcopal Church and of the Mational Council fo Churchesof Christ in the United States of America (NCCCUSA) has been discussed on a number of occasions. Our priest, was a delegate to the recent triennial General Convention of the Church held in Detroit and reported that in the committee meeting where the NCCCUSA was discussed no mention was made of communism. 

# FBI: Wide Communist Infiltration in Churches a 'Falsehood'

Once again charges of Communistic infiltration are being hurled against U.S. churches. Here statements from the FBI show how such wild claims by anti-Communist "vigilantes" are actually welcomed by the Reds.

### By LOUIS CASSELS, United Press International

No rational person can be a sincere Christian and a sincere Communist.

Communists know this. That is why they persecute Christian churches—sometimes openly, sometimes subtly—in every country in which they have gained power, from Russia to Cuba.

In free nations like America, Communists cannot suppress the churches but must think of other tactics.

Undoubtedly they have tried in the past to infiltrate churches by having disguised Communists work their way up to leadership, particularly in the clergy.

They have learned that this is easier said than done. It is difficult for a Communist to pose convincingly as a dedicated Christian even for the space of one conversation, let alone through the long years of seminary study and pulpit service required of any man who becomes an influential leader in U.S. church life.

### Discredit-Leadership.

Although they have failed to infiltrate the churches in any substantial way, there is evidence that the Communists like it when charges are made that they actually have done so.

The Communists know that in the present climate of American feeling, there is no surer way of discrediting the leadership of churches and of sowing confusion and discord among their lay members than for the suspicion to be nour-

ished that a substantial number of Christian clergymen a. secret supporters of the Communist conspiracy.

You may think all of this is far-fetched. But the Federal Bureau of Investigation does not.

FBI director J. Edgar Hoover is deeply concerned about the danger that self-appointed "vigilantes" may, in the name of anti-communism, play into the Communists' hands.

During the past few weeks, Mr. Hoover has sent FBI Chief Inspector William C. Sullivan to deliver speeches in many parts of the nation, warning Americans not to be taken in by charges that their churches are every, a with Reds.

### Charge is Takehood!

"These allegations have served to create the impression among many Americans that the Protestant denominations in particular have been subjected to alarming infiltration and influence," Mr. Sullivan says.

"But this is a patent falsehood. The truth is that the Communist party has not achieved any substantial success in exerting domination, control or influence over America's clergymen or religious institutions on a national scale."

Mr. Sullivan is not making this statement on his own authority. He is speaking with the full approval and personal backing of Mr. Hoover. And the FBI director has so informed a number of amateur Communist hunters, who wrote to him protesting Mr. Sullivan's speeches.

"The most interesting reaction," an FMI official told United Press International, "has been from the Communists. They are very upset by Mr. Sullivan's remarks.


"They love to have wild charges of Communist domination hurled against America's churches. They know that such charges cause consternation, dissension, doubt and fear among church members. And they figure that anyone who succeeds in demoralizing America's churches is aiding their cause."

I am a Vethodist minister, with a long previous background of law enforcement, with one of the very large and outstanding law enforcement agencies of our country.

I write this at the behest of one of my parishioners, who is fearful that I have allowed myself to become a "dupe" of the forces of Communism, in some moderately "liberal" views which I hold.

The particular reference in which this lady requested me to write to you is in reference to the National Council of Churches. I am perfectly satisfied that this organization is one of the great forces for good in our present scene, and one whose loyalty and patriotism are above reproach,—in fact, one of the potent forces against Communist influence in our country.

My parishioner, on the other hand, is satisfied that the Council is not only questionable in itself, but is honeycombed with subversive elements.

Personally, I have become weary of this latter point of view, with which I am very familiar. Yet, I promised to write to you for your opinion of the National Council, in this regard. I am aware that across the history of the Federal Council, and its successor, the National Council, there have been a few who have courted the Communist point of view, from idealistic motives, most of whom have since become disabused of their Communist leanings. It is my belief that none of these persons has ever held any important office in the Council, with the possible exception of one man, who fifty years ago, for a short period, did held such office. He is now an old man, and no longer to be seriously reckoned with.

While these are my convictions, besed on observation and study, I ar open to honest evidence. In your considered opinion, is the National

Council of Churches a dangerous organization, from the standpoint of Communist infiltration?

In closing, let me, as a law enforcement officer, as a minister, and as a citizen, express my utmost confidence in the Federal Bureau of Investigation in its responsibility of guarding against the infiltrative inroads of Communism. I wish I might say as much for some of the amateur groups having official status, who are so active in the field.



Your letter of September 1, 1961, has been received, and the concern you expressed regarding the menace of communian is indeed appreciated.

Although I would like to be of service, the FBI is an investigative agency of the Federal Government and, as such, does not make evaluations nor draw conclusions as to the character or integrity of any organization, publication or individual. I regret that I am unable to help you and hope that you will not infer in this connection either that we do or that we do not have data in our files relating to the subjects of your inquiries.

With respect to your discussion, in my book, "Masters of Deceit," I pointed out that it is a continuing program of the Communist Party to attempt infiltration of every part of our society, including religion. This is still true today. Fortunately, this evil conspiracy has not made any substantial penetration into our religious organizations. I would like to emphasize, however, that churches will continue to be important targets in the over-all subversive plan of endeavoring to control our established institutions, and we must remain alert to any attempts to replace our national traditions with the atheistic philosophy of communism.

Dear Mr. Hoover:

You are the nation's number one authority on communism and the threat which it presents to America today. Because of this I write to you.

My wife and I are both members of the First Baptist Church here in Our church is a member, in turn, of the American Baptist Association. There has been a great deal of talk in our congregation lately to the effect that our association has become too large and that the people are becoming to remote to the organization itself. The chief fear that we have is that the organization may do things, or stand for things which we as individual members cannot subscribe to, and yet we may not know enough about our hig organization to know what they really are supporting.

We as an association are members of the National Council of Churches. Kany believe this organisation, although pretending to be Christian, has communist infiltration to the point that it is classed as a subversive organisation. Just last week I heard a man speak (Garl Presson - sp.) who has spent 26 years in the Communist Party but who just recently renounced the organization and became a Christian. He claimed that the National Council of Churches was not infiltrated, that it was founded by the Communists to serve as a front organization for them.

Would you be so kind as to give me the standing of the N. C. of C. according to your knowledge, as well as the Freedom Rider movement, and Mr. Martin Luther King?
