We will seek to live our lives in various ways according to individual desires and objectives.

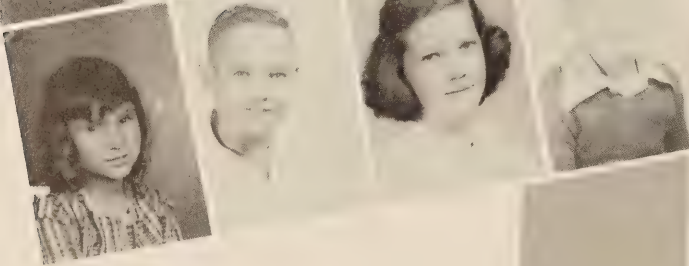
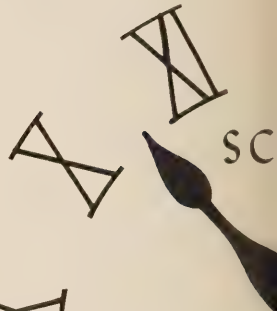
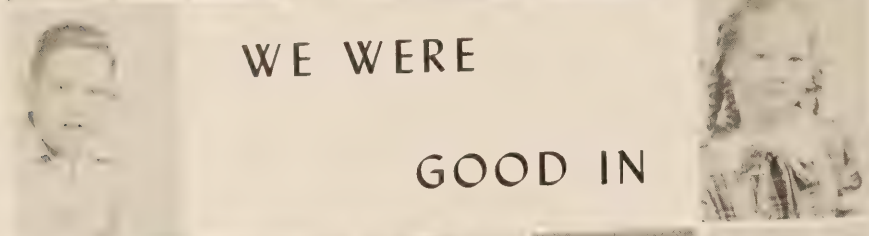
