



"The Old Dutch Church
Sleepy Hollow," near
Tarrytown, N. Y.

The Old Dutch Church is the oldest on the Hudson, and was made from brick and stone brought from Holland by Frederick Philipse and his wife, Katrina Von Cortland, in 1690. In the burial-yard adjoining is the grave of Washington Irving and a plain slab with this simple inscription:

Born April 3, 1783
Died
November 28, 1859.
