INTRODUCTION

The Occupational Employment Statistics (OES) program is made possible by the cooperation of those Illinois employers who willingly contributed their time and effort to complete the Survey questionnaire.

The OES survey is a Federal-State cooperative program which identifies occupations by industry. The survey is conducted on a three-year cycle, rotating industry groups in and out. Manufacturing industries are surveyed together; nonmanufacturing industries are divided and surveyed over two years. This report combines two surveys in order to present Health Services as entity: 1986 Survey of Hospitals and the 1984 Survey of Selected Nonmanufacturing Industries.

OES surveys are conducted primarily by mail using questionnaires specifically adapted to the occupational structure of each industry. Occupations are included either because they are numerically important to the industry or require substantial training. Employment data (for the week including the 12th of the survey month) are requested from each employer, who may use personnel records or personal knowledge to respond.

USER'S GUIDE

Occupations appear in approximately the same sequence for each industry and are organized into divisions:

- Managerial and Administrative
- Professional, Paraprofessional, Technical
- Sales and related
- Clerical and Administrative Support
- Service
- Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing, and related
- Production, Construction, Operating, Maintenance, and Material Handling

Some abbreviated titles require explanations:

X	Excluding/except
TECHNO	Technologist
TECHNI	Technician

In addition to the estimated number of workers in each occupation and the occupation's share-of-industry total, the relative error is shown.

The relative error is a measure of the reliability of the sample: the lower the relative error, the higher the reliability of the sample. More precisely, the relative error can be interpreted in either of the following ways:

- the chances are 2 out of 3 that the results of a similar survey would not differ from the results of the OES Survey by more than the percent shown, or
- the chances are 19 out of 20 that the results of a 100 percent sample would not differ from the results of the OES Survey by more than the percent shown.

GLOSSARY AND TECHNICAL NOTES

SIC - Standard Industrial Code, as described in the 1972 Standard Industrial Classification Manual, Executive Office of the President, Office of Management and Budget, Statistical Policy Division.

Federal-State Cooperative Program - Programs funded wholly or partially by the U.S. Department of Labor and conducted by states following national guidelines; assures state-to-state comparability.

Publication Criteria - For each SIC, employment must total 1,000 or more, the number of respondents must total 3 or more, and employment for all publishable occupations must total more than 70 percent of the SIC total. For each occupation employment must be greater than 10, and the relative error must be less than 50 percent.

Sampling and Estimating - The sample used in the 1986 Survey of Hospitals was drawn from the 1985 Covered Employment and Wages Report (ES-202), which is prepared quarterly for all employers covered under the Illinois Unemployment Insurance Act. The sample was stratified by industry and employment size-class. All establishments with 250 or more employees were included in the sample; smaller establishments were sampled according to predetermined ratios.

Additional information on Survey methods and concepts can be found in the BLS Handbook of Methods published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor (312-353-1880).
