

### SAN FRANCISCO OFFICIAL ROLL OFFICIAL ROLL

1846-1894.

On the 8th day of July, 1846, war existing between the United States and Mexico, an Francisco was formally taken possession of by Captain John B. Montgomery, comiding the U. S. Sloop-of-War "Portsmouth," who appointed Lieut. Washington A. rtlett, Alcalde, or Chief Magistrate. The roll of Alcaldes after the American occuon, with their periods, is as follows:
