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## SAN FRANCISCO OFFICIAL ROLL CVL 1846-1894.

On the 8th day of July, 1846, war existing between the United States and Mexico, an Francisco was formally taken possession of by Captain John B. Montgomery, comnding the U.S. Sloop-of-War "Portsmouth," who appointed Lieut. Washington A. artlett, Alcalde, or Chief Magistrate. The roll of Alcaldes after the American occuon, with their periods, is as follows :
