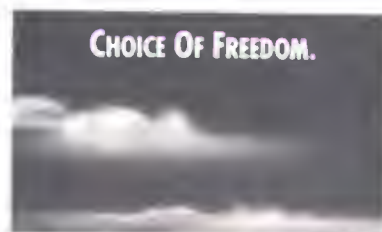
## M15 PLUS: a choice of freedom

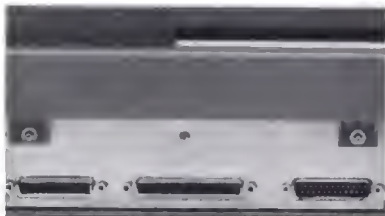




## M15 PLUS is compatible

The most important feature is its compatibility, particularly for those who collect data and process information "in the field" and like to look things over later. Furthermore, despite its size, the M15 PLUS has been carefully designed to support the various versions of MS-DOS – including 3.3.

On account of this, it can exchange information with the desktop computers, and the elder floor-standing brothers of the Olivetti family. In addition, it can talk with any industry standard personal computer on the market – either directly or through a local area network.



## M15 PLUS is easy to use

Imagine parking your 4-wheel drive vehicle on the side of a mountain, setting up a theodolite, and placing your M15 PLUS on the bonnet. You can then take measurements and make calculations. In a few minutes, the design of the dam is sketched. Moving the keyboard to a more convenient position if necessary, you make your corrections on the spot, all made easier by the high readability of the monitor.

Then if suddenly it begins to drizzle, the screen is quickly closed on the keyboard and the PC slips into its carrying case. This also contains the mains adapter, an essential device. Even if we didn't realize it, time has gone by: after almost six hours of continuous operation, even the M15 PLUS needs a recharge.

## M15 PLUS is a professional tool

You can fully exploit your professional abilities when you are able to use the power of the personal computer – anywhere.

It is this that led Olivetti to design a PC that satisfies these needs. The M15 PLUS, despite its size, has been designed with the same philosophy that is behind the other Olivetti personal computers: functionality, ergonomics, quality and reliability.

Its technological characteristics identify it as a fully professional tool. It solves many problems in a wide range of situations. All this without you having to wait hours, or travel miles, before putting your hands on one of its elder brothers.

In a nutshell, it features: an 80C88 CMOS (Complementary Metal Ox-

ide Semiconductor) 16-bit microprocessor with 4.77 MHz clock speed, MS-DOS 3.3 operating system, and 512 KB RAM.

Two versions are available offering a choice of disk drives: 2x3.5" 720 KB floppy disk drive (with socket to connect optional external HDU) or: 1x3.5" 720 KB floppy disk drive and 1x20 MB integrated hard disk. Both versions have a socket for connecting an optional external 5.25" floppy disk drive.

Input/output devices: 10.5" LCD backlit monitor, with a maximum resolution of 640x320 pixels. The 78-

key keyboard is detachable, available in various national versions and offers simulated n-key rollover.

Interfaces: Centronics parallel, RS 232-C serial.

All this weighs in at just six kilos. This outstanding briefcase computer is a state of the art solution to current and future needs. Last but not least, it offers a price/performance ratio that is the best on the market. The M15 PLUS is undoubtedly THE small PC providing big solutions.
