The Illinois Department of Employment Security has the most comprehensive and reliable information about the state's workforce!

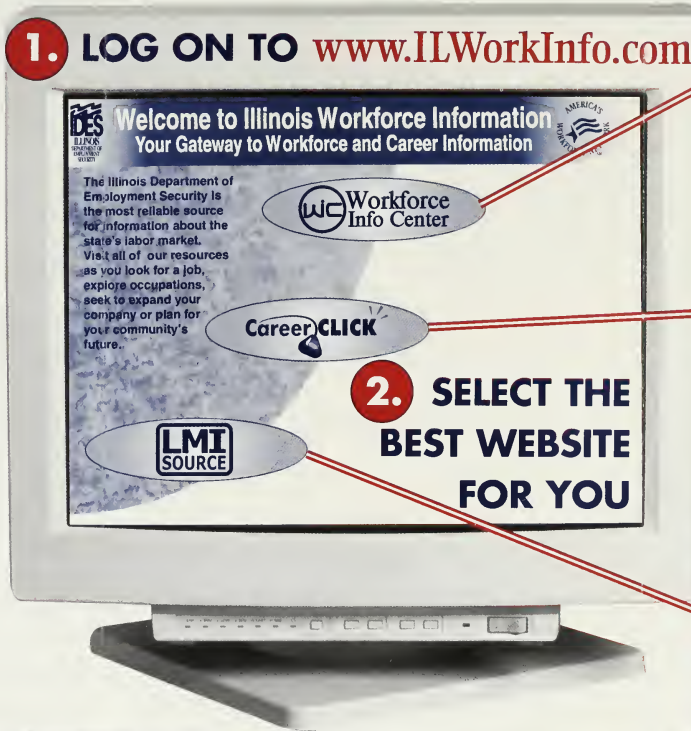
