TAS AMENDED BY THE COMMITTEE

To amend an Act of the last Session of Parliament. for amending the Irish Road Acts.

BEREAS by an Act made in the last Session of Parliament, Presentle, 49 Gree COI & intituled, "An Act for amending the Irift Road Acts," it was till e. 84. L 18. among other things enacted, that from and after the end of the feveral Lent Affizes which thall be held in Ireland in the year one thousand eight hundred and ten, no Affidavit for the accounting for the repairs of any Road shall be allowed by the Grand Jury or by the Court 'at any Affizes or Prefenting Term in or for any County or County of a City

or Town in Ireland, unless it shall be specially stated in such Affidavit that there is not on either fide of any part of the Road specified in such Affidavit any grip trench or drain without a wall or other fufficient defence between such grip trench or drain and the side of such Road:

And whereas in many parts of Ireland the building of such Walls or Expenses of lenity other fufficient Fences may be attended with great expence;

Be it therefore Enafted by the KING's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Confent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the fame. That it shall and may be lawful for any Overseer, in any fuch Affidavit for the accounting for the repairs of any Road (not being a Road on which His Majefly's Mails are conveyed in Mail Coaches or four-wheeled Carriages drawn by two or more horses) to flate specially that to the best of the skill and judgment of such Overseer a wall could HA is sates that not be built or any other fufficient fence be made between any fuch the kepence of interest and the following state of the property of the pro grip trench or drain and the fide of fuch Road at fo fmall an expense exceed a certain as One Shilling and Sixpence by the perch; in lieu and inflead of Sem, the recent flating, as required by the faid recited Act, that "there is not any grip be allowed. trench or drain without a wall or other fufficient fence between the same and the fide of the Road;" and it shall be lawful for the Grand Jury or the Court at any fuch Affizes or Presenting Term, in case they shall be of opinion that it is not necessary that such wall or other sufficient sence should be built, but not otherwise, to allow such Affidavit; any thing in the faid recited Act to the contrary notwithflanding,

And

And be it further Enacted, That in all cases where any new line of Road shall have been surveyed approved of and presented by any Grand CLAUSE (A.) Empowering Grand Junes Jury and Court at any Affizes or Prefenting Term, whereby any Mail to allow Affi-Coach Road now in use or any part of such Road thall be proposed to be avoided; and also in all cases of accounting for the repairs of any Mounting

or other Crofs Roads (not being Mail Coach Roads or Roads on which His Majesty's Judges travel in their progress on their respective Circuits) it shall be lawful for the Grand Jury and the Court to allow any Affidavit for accounting for the temporary repair of the part of fuch Mail Coarh Road as is fo to be avoided, and also to allow any Affidavit for the renar of any fuch Mountain or other Crofs Road, although it shall not be specially flated in any fuch Affidavit " that there is not on either fide of any part of " the Road specified in such Affidavit any grip trench or drain without " a wall or other fufficient defence between fuch grip trench or drain " and the fide of fuch Road; " any thing in the faid recited Act of the lair Session of Parliament to the contrary notwithstanding,

And be it Enacted, That in every Affidavit for accounting for any Pre-
