Be it therefore enaoted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :---

1. The Order set out in the schedule hereto is hereby confirmed Orders in 10 and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force.

2. This Act may be cited as the Local Government Board Short title. (Ireland) Provisional Order Confirmation (No. 4) Act 1898.

 - It is ordered by the Local Government Board as follows :--
 - 1. Upon the confirmation of this Order by Parliament section 48 sub-Assentances of section (1) of the Act of 1896 shall be amended as follows :--- The words Carpornice therein contained " any rate made in respect thereof under the local A " Acts " shall be strock out and there shall be substituted for the said " 48 (1).
 - words the words " any rate other than poor rate or county cess made in " respect thereof under any Act in force for the time being including " this Act."
 - 2. The costs charges and expenses of and incidental to the application for Costs of Order. preparation obtaining and confirming this Order shall be paid by the Corporation out of the rate called the general purposes rate.
 - 3. This Order may be cited and referred to as the Belfast (Local Act Short life of Amendment) Provisional Order 1898.
