- So rife was body snatching that certain graveyards had large walls, railings and watchtowers erected

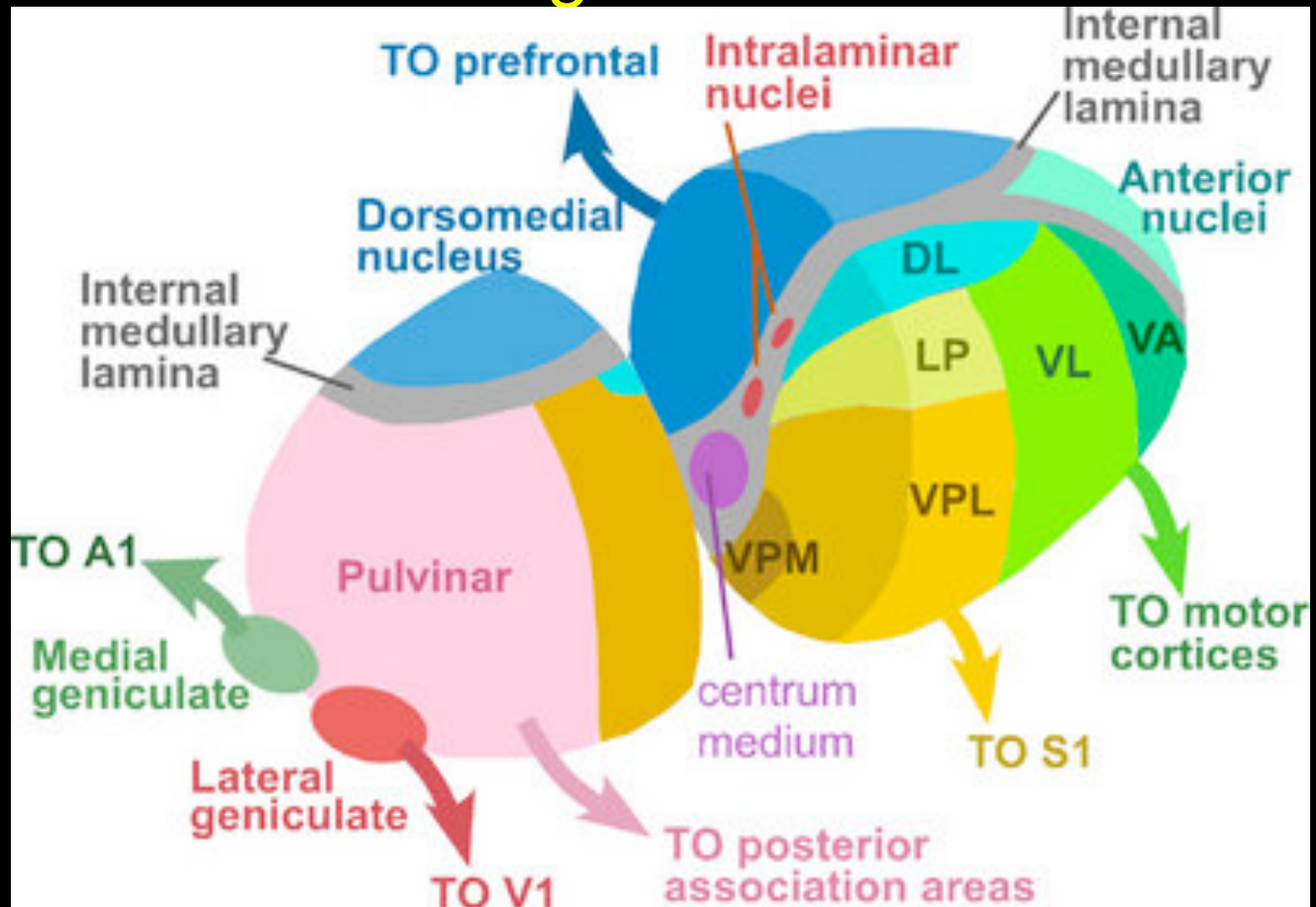
Texas-style justice?
