



## TROPICAL CYCLONE ADVISORY #1 FOR: Tropical Storm ATSANI

**ISSUED AT 5:00 PM, 30 October 2020**

**TROPICAL STORM "ATSANI" ACCELERATES WEST-NORTHWESTWARD WHILE MAINTAINING ITS STRENGTH.**

**Track and intensity outlook:**

- Track: "ATSANI" will move generally northwestward as it moves towards the eastern boundary of the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR). It may enter the PAR on Sunday.
- Intensity: Continuous intensification is expected. "ATSANI" is forecast to intensify into severe tropical storm in the next 24 to 36 hours.

**Hazards affecting land and coastal waters:**

- This tropical storm is less likely to bring severe weather over any portion of the country over the next 3 days.

**Other information:**

- The international name "ATSANI", which means lightning flash, was contributed by Thailand.
- Once inside the PAR, it will be given the local name "SIONY".

**The public and the disaster risk reduction and management council concerned are advised to monitor for the next update on this weather disturbance to be incorporated in the Public Weather Forecast at 4 AM tomorrow and in the next advisory at 11 AM Tomorrow.**

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
