"BISING" TRANSITIONS INTO AN EXTRATROPICAL CYCLONE AND IS NOW OUTSIDE THE PHILIPPINE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY (PAR).


Track and Intensity Outlook

- "BISING" left the PAR at 5:40 AM today.
- At 8:00 AM today, "BISING" transitioned into a gale-force extratropical cyclone.

Hazards affecting coastal waters

In the next 24 hours, under the influence of an extratropical cyclone outside PAR, moderate to rough seas will be experienced over the northern and eastern seaboards of Northern Luzon (1.5 to 3.5 m) and the eastern seaboards of Central and Southern Luzon (1.2 to 3.0 m). Mariners of small seacrafts are advised not to venture out over these waters. Inexperienced mariners of these vessels should avoid navigating in these conditions.

At 10:00 AM today, the center of the Extratropical Cyclone (formerly "BISING") was estimated based on all available data at 1,500 km East of Extreme Northern Luzon (OUTSIDE PAR) (21.8°N, 136.3°E).
