Location of Center (10:00 AM)


The center of Tropical Depression "DANTE" was estimated based on all available data at 820 km East of Mindanao (6.1°N, 133.3°E)

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HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS

Heavy Rainfall

In the next 24 hours, the outer rainbands of "DANTE" may bring light to moderate with at times heavy rains over Caraga and Davao Region. Under these conditions, isolated to scattered flooding (including flash floods) and rain-induced landslides are possible, especially in areas that are highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards as identified in hazard maps. Adjacent or nearby areas may also experience flooding in the absence of such rainfall occurrence due to surface runoff or swelling of river channels.

Severe Wind

The present track forecast shows that the hoisting of Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal (TCWS) over any land area in the country remains less likely. However, given the uncertainty in its track forecast, any further westward shift in the track forecast may lead to the hoisting of TCWS over the eastern portion of the country.

TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK

- There is an increasing likelihood that "DANTE" will reach tropical storm category area by tomorrow morning.
- "DANTE" entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) at 1:00 AM today. On the forecast track, the tropical depression is forecast to continue moving northwestward until Tuesday evening before turning north northwestward for the rest of the forecast period.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measures to protect life and property. Persons living in areas identified to be highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards are advised to follow evacuation and other instructions from local officials. For heavy rainfall warnings, thunderstorm/rainfall advisories, and other severe weather information specific to your area, please monitor products issued by your local PAGASA Regional Services Division.

Unless an intermediate bulletin is released, the next tropical cyclone bulletin will be issued at 5:00 PM today.
