Issued at 5:00 PM, 30 May 2021

TROPICAL DEPRESSION "DANTE" DECELERATES AND IS NOW MOVING WEST NORTHWESTWARD OVER THE PHILIPPINE SEA EAST OF MINDANAO.

Location of Center (4:00 PM)


The center of Tropical Depression "DANTE" was estimated based on all available data at 835 km East of Mindanao (6.4°N, 132.6°E)

Intensity

Maximum sustained winds of **55 km/h** near the center, gustiness up to **70 km/h**, and central pressure of **1002 hPa**

Present Movement

West Northwestward at 15 km/h

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HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS

Heavy Rainfall

- Today until tomorrow evening, light to moderate with at times heavy rains will be experienced over Caraga and Davao Region due to the outer rainbands of "DANTE".
- Under these conditions, isolated to scattered flooding (including flash floods) and rain-induced landslides are
 possible, especially in areas that are highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards as identified in hazard
 maps. Adjacent or nearby areas may also experience flooding in the absence of such rainfall occurrence due to
 surface runoff or swelling of river channels.

Severe Wind

• The present track forecast shows that the hoisting of Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal (TCWS) over any land area in the country remains less likely. However, given the uncertainty in its track forecast, any further westward shift in the track forecast may lead to the hoisting of TCWS over the eastern portion of the country.

TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK

- There is an increasing likelihood that "DANTE" will reach tropical storm category area by tomorrow morning and will slightly intensify until Wednesday. By Wednesday evening, "DANTE" is forecast to weaken into a Tropical Depression and will become a remnant Low on Friday.
- On the forecast track, the tropical depression is forecast to continue moving northwestward until Wednesday evening before turning north northeastward for the rest of the forecast period.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measures to protect life and property. Persons living in areas identified to be highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards are advised to follow evacuation and other instructions from local officials. For heavy rainfall warnings, thunderstorm/rainfall advisories, and other severe weather information specific to your area, please monitor products issued by your local PAGASA Regional Services Division.

Unless an intermediate bulletin is released, the next tropical cyclone bulletin will be issued at 11:00 PM today.
