TROPICAL STORM "DANTE" IS NOW OVER THE VERDE ISLAND PASSAGE AND IS MOVING TOWARDS THE SOUTHWESTERN COAST OF BATANGAS

The center of Tropical Storm "DANTE" (CHOI-WAN) was estimated based on all available data over the coastal waters of Calapan, Oriental Mindoro (13.6°N, 120.9°E)

Maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center, gustiness up to 90 km/h , and central pressure of 998 hPa

Northwestward at 20 km/h

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HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS
<p>Heavy Rainfall</p> <p>Today through tomorrow afternoon, Tropical Storm "DANTE" is forecast to bring:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Moderate to heavy with at times intense rains over Cavite, Batangas, Romblon, Marinduque, Occidental Mindoro, Oriental Mindoro, Bataan, Zambales, and Pangasinan. Moderate to heavy rains over the rest of Central Luzon and CALABARZON, the northern portion of Palawan including Calamian, Cuyo, and Cagayancillo Islands, and the northwestern portion of Aklan and Antique. Light to moderate with at times heavy rains over Metro Manila, Camarines Norte, Camarines Sur, La Union, Ilocos Sur, Mountain Province, Kalinga, Abra, Benguet, Nueva Vizcaya, Quirino, and the rest of MIMAROPA. Under these conditions and considering antecedent rainfall, scattered to widespread flooding (including flash floods) and rain-induced landslides are expected, especially in areas with high or very high susceptibility to these hazards as identified in hazard maps. Adjacent or nearby areas may also experience flooding in the absence of such rainfall occurrence due to surface runoff or swelling of river channels. <p>Severe Winds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Strong winds to gale-force winds are possible over the areas where Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal #2 is hoisted. Such conditions may bring generally light to moderate damage to structures and vegetation. Strong winds (strong breeze to near gale) which may cause generally very light damage to structures and vegetation may be experienced in areas where TCWS #1 is in effect.
HAZARDS AFFECTING COASTAL WATERS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the next 24 hours, rough to very rough seas (2.5 to 4.0 m) will be experienced over the seaboard of areas where TCWS #2 is in effect. Sea travel is risky for small seacrafts over these waters. Mariners without the proper experience should immediately seek safe harbor. Moderate to rough seas (1.2 to 3.0 m) over the seaboard of areas where TCWS #1 is in effect, eastern seaboard of Quezon, eastern seaboard of Bicol Region, and the western seaboard of Visayas. Mariners of small seacrafts are advised to take precautionary measures when venturing out to sea. Inexperienced mariners should avoid navigating in these conditions.
TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> "DANTE" is forecast to move generally north northwestward or northwestward and may pass near or in the vicinity of the southwestern portion of Batangas tonight and Bataan and Zambales tomorrow early morning. It will then emerge over the West Philippine Sea tomorrow morning. Due to land interaction with the rugged terrain of mainland Luzon, "DANTE" is forecast to weaken into a tropical depression tonight or tomorrow morning and by Saturday, it will become a Low Pressure Area.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measures to protect life and property. Persons living in areas identified to be highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards are advised to follow evacuation and other instructions from local officials. **For heavy rainfall warnings, thunderstorm/rainfall advisories, and other severe weather information specific to your area, please monitor products issued by your local PAGASA Regional Services Division.**

Unless an intermediate bulletin is released, the next tropical cyclone bulletin will be issued at 11:00 PM today.
