Tropical Storm "DANTE" (CHOI-WAN)

Issued at 5:00 AM, 3 June 2021

Valid for broadcast until the next bulletin at 8:00 AM today.

"DANTE" IS NOW OVER THE COASTAL WATERS OF NORTHERN ZAMBALES AFTER PASSING VERY CLOSE TO THE WESTERN COAST OF CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN ZAMBALES.

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HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS
<p>Heavy Rainfall</p> <p>Today, Tropical Storm “DANTE” is forecast to bring:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Moderate to heavy rains over Pangasinan, Zambales, Bataan, Occidental Mindoro including Lubang Islands, the northern portion of Palawan including Calamian Islands. Light to moderate with at times heavy rains over Ilocos Region, Cordillera Administrative Region, Nueva Ecija, Tarlac, Pampanga, Bulacan, Metro Manila, CALABARZON, Oriental Mindoro, and the rest of Palawan including Cuyo and Kalayaan Islands Under these conditions, scattered (becoming widespread in areas with significant antecedent rainfall) flooding (including flash floods) and rain-induced landslides are expected, especially in areas with high or very high susceptibility to these hazards as identified in hazard maps. Adjacent or nearby areas may also experience flooding in the absence of such rainfall occurrence due to surface runoff or swelling of river channels. <p>Severe Winds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Strong winds to gale-force winds are possible over the areas where Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal #2 is hoisted. Such conditions may bring generally light to moderate damage to structures and vegetation. Strong winds (strong breeze to near gale) which may cause generally very light damage to structures and vegetation may be experienced in areas where TCWS #1 is in effect.
HAZARDS AFFECTING COASTAL WATERS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the next 24 hours, rough to very rough seas (2.5 to 4.0 m) will be experienced over the seaboard of areas where TCWS #2 is in effect. Sea travel is risky for small seacrafts over these waters. Mariners without the proper experience should immediately seek safe harbor. Moderate to rough seas (1.2 to 3.0 m) over the seaboard of areas where TCWS #1 is in effect, the remaining seaboard of Northern Luzon, the eastern seaboard of Central Luzon, the remaining seaboard of CALABARZON, the remaining seaboard of Mindoro Provinces, the seaboard of Marinduque, and the western seaboard of Romblon. Mariners of small seacrafts are advised to take precautionary measures when venturing out to sea. Inexperienced mariners should avoid navigating in these conditions.
TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Today, “DANTE” will continue tracking generally north northwestward over the coastal waters of Zambales and Pangasinan, then turn more northward over the West Philippine Sea. After turning to the northeast tomorrow morning, “DANTE” will move over the Bashi Channel (in the Luzon Strait) close to the southern coast of Taiwan. Given the present track forecast scenario, “DANTE” is forecast to be downgraded into a tropical depression in the next 12 hours and into a remnant low by Saturday morning.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measures to protect life and property. Persons living in areas identified to be highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards are advised to follow evacuation and other instructions from local officials. **For heavy rainfall warnings, thunderstorm/rainfall advisories, and other severe weather information specific to your area, please monitor products issued by your local PAGASA Regional Services Division.**

Unless an intermediate bulletin is released, the next tropical cyclone bulletin will be issued at 8:00 AM today.
