# TROPICAL STORM "DANTE" MAINTAINS ITS STRENGTH WHILE MOVING NORTHWESTWARD OVER THE WEST PHILIPPINE SEA.

## Location of Center (10:00 AM)

The center of Tropical Storm "DANTE" (CHOI-WAN) was estimated based on all available data 205 km West Northwest of Dagupan City, Pangasinan or 190 km West Southwest of Sinait, Ilocos Sur (17.0°N, 118.7°E).

## Intensity


Maximum sustained winds of **65 km/h** near the center, gustiness up to **90 km/h**, and central pressure of **998 hPa** 

### **Present Movement**

Northwestward at 35 km/h

### **Extent of Tropical Cyclone Winds**

Gale-force winds extend outward up to **50 km** from the center.

#### HAZARDS AFFECTING COASTAL WATERS

- Gale warning is in effect over the northern and western seaboards of Northern Luzon (2.6 to 4.5 m). Sea travel is
  risky for small sea crafts over these waters.
- Moderate to rough seas (1.5 to 3.5 m) will be experienced over the western seaboard of Northern Luzon. Mariners
  of small seacrafts are advised to take precautionary measures when venturing out to sea. Inexperienced mariners
  should avoid navigating in these conditions.

### TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK

- Over the West Philippine Sea, "DANTE" will continue moving generally north northwestward or northward in the next 12 hours before turning north northeastward tomorrow morning and northeastward tomorrow afternoon or evening. "DANTE" will be over the Bashi Channel tomorrow afternoon or evening.
- "DANTE" is forecast to remain tropical storm in the next 12 hours. It will weaken into a tropical depression tomorrow and into a remnant low on Saturday.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measures to protect life and property. Persons living in areas identified to be highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards are advised to follow evacuation and other instructions from local officials. For heavy rainfall warnings, thunderstorm/rainfall advisories, and other severe weather information specific to your area, please monitor products issued by your local PAGASA Regional Services Division.

Unless an intermediate bulletin is released, the next tropical cyclone bulletin will be issued at 5:00 PM today.
