HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS

Severe Winds

Areas where Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal (TCWS) #1 is hoisted will be experiencing strong winds (strong to near gale) during the passage of "DANTE".

HAZARDS AFFECTING COASTAL WATERS

• A Gale Warning remains in effect over the northern seaboard of Northern Luzon (2.8 to 4.0 m) due to rough seas. Sea travel is risky for small seacrafts over these waters. Mariners without the proper experience should immediately seek safe harbor. For more information, refer to Gale Warning #4 issued at 5:00 PM today.

TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK

- "DANTE" re-entered the PAR at 4:00 PM today. This tropical depression is forecast to move northeastward throughout the forecast period. On the forecast track, "DANTE" will make a close approach or landfall in the vicinity of southern Taiwan (i.e., Pingtung County area) tonight. Afterwards, "DANTE" will continue moving northeastward towards East China Sea and will left the PAR tomorrow afternoon
- "DANTE" weakened into a tropical depression at 2:00 PM today. This tropical cyclone is forecast to transition into an extratropical cyclone tomorrow over the East China Sea.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measures to protect life and property. Persons living in areas identified to be highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards are advised to follow evacuation and other instructions from local officials. For heavy rainfall warnings, thunderstorm/rainfall advisories, and other severe weather information specific to your area, please monitor products issued by your local PAGASA Regional Services Division.

Unless an intermediate bulletin is released, the next tropical cyclone bulletin will be issued at 5:00 PM today.
