### TROPICAL DEPRESSION "DANTE" PASSES VERY CLOSE TO THE SOUTHERN TIP OF MAINLAND TAIWAN AND THE NEARBY ORCHID ISLAND.

### Location of Center (10:00 PM)


The center of Tropical Depression "DANTE" (CHOl-WAN) was estimated based on all available data at 160 km North of Itbayat, Batanes or over the coastal waters of Orchid Island, Taiwan (22.2°N, 121.6°E).

### Intensity

Maximum sustained winds of **55 km/h** near the center, gustiness up to **70 km/h**, and central pressure of **1000 hPa** 

### **Present Movement**

East northeastward at 35 km/h

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### HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS

#### **Severe Winds**

Batanes will continue to experience strong winds (strong to near gale) due to the "DANTE" within the next 6 hours. However, winds will gradually weaken during the period as the tropical depression moves further away. As such, there is a high likelihood that wind signal over the province will be lifted tomorrow morning.

### HAZARDS AFFECTING COASTAL WATERS

• A Gale Warning remains in effect over the northern seaboard of Northern Luzon (2.8 to 4.0 m) due to rough seas. Sea travel is risky for small seacrafts over these waters. Mariners without the proper experience should immediately seek safe harbor. For more information, refer to Gale Warning #4 issued at 5:00 PM today.

### TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK

- "DANTE" is forecast to move generally northeastwards towards the vicinity of Yaeyama Islands in the Ryukyu Archipelago and may specifically pass very close or over the Ishigaki Island tomorrow morning. On the forecast track, the tropical depression will likely exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility tomorrow morning or noon.
- This tropical cyclone is forecast to transition into an extratropical cyclone tomorrow afternoon or evening over the East China Sea while interacting with the Mei-yu frontal boundary.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measures to protect life and property. Persons living in areas identified to be highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards are advised to follow evacuation and other instructions from local officials. For heavy rainfall warnings, thunderstorm/rainfall advisories, and other severe weather information specific to your area, please monitor products issued by your local PAGASA Regional Services Division.

Unless an intermediate bulletin is released, the next tropical cyclone bulletin will be issued at 5:00 AM tomorrow.
